

### 導言

對於英語的初學者,以及很多已有一定程度的學習者 而幫,當他們在和說英語的同伴對談時,與活用英語上, 經常會犯了一些奇怪、滑稽和令人咋舌的錯誤。他們常常 會使用錯誤的單字,錯誤的詞類變化,錯誤的文法形式, 或者一些不正確的發音。閱讀「測試您的英語實力!」這 三本書後,將會使每位英語的學習者都能正確的掌握,並 且克服上述的一些常犯的錯誤。英語知識的累積也將藉由 最有效的方法,有系統的建立起來。

這三本書的測驗原理,是採用多樣選擇的方法。也就 是說;在每一道英文題目之後,必須從五個選擇項目之中 選出一個正確的答案來。然後對照後面的解答,可以自己 檢查答案是否正確,那裏也說明了選擇正確答案的理由何 在,以及其他相關問題的解釋。

本書所採用的方法,有別於傳統的學習方式。它們是

活潑的,有趣的,是學習英語的最佳捷徑。採用問題的方式,是爲了讓讀者能不定期的自我測試,即使是在短短的時間裏,亦可充分的利用。俾能使讀者花最少的時間,而收到最大的效果。

另外,本書的選題方法是建立在現代語言學的知識基礎上。作者布魯坦(G·Broughton)是英國倫敦大學英語教師學系主任。作者其他許多成功的英文教材,正嘉惠着全世界衆多的英語學習者。
