# 前 言

在中国,由于英语作为外语而不是第二语言的特殊语言 学习环境和教学方法等诸多因素的影响,听力作为一项基本 语言技能一直是我国英语学习者的难点之一。而新闻英语听 力由于自身在结构、语法和词汇等方面的特点,更是难点中的 难点。提高新闻英语听力不仅可以学习标准的英语发音和英 语语法,而且可以了解国际时事政治。《英语听力指南》就是 本着这些目的而设计编写的。

本书共有八个单元,分别涉及军事、国内政治、国际政治、 经济、法律、体育、灾难和科技等方面的时事新闻,同时书中附 有练习参考答案和录音的书面材料。

和国内现有的新闻英语听力教材相比,本书具有以下几个特点:

- 1. 内容时效性强, 所有听力材料均选自 VOA(美国之音)、BBC(英国广播公司)及 CCTV(中国中央电视台)近两年播出的时事新闻。
- 2. 每个单元都包含特殊英语(Special English)和正常英语(Normal English)两部分,可以纵向和横向使用,方便不同英语水平的学习者。
- 3. 每个单元都包含中心词汇,即经常出现在同类新闻中的单词,使学习者在收听同类新闻时可以事半功倍。

4. 每单元都设有练习,便于学习者检查自己的理解程度;书中还附有练习参考答案和录音书面材料,便于学习者核对。

本书适合具有高中以上英语水平的英语专业、非英语专业大学生,以及具有同等英语水平、社会各层次的广大英语爱好者。

由于时间仓促和编者水平所限,书中错误和不足之处在所难免,恳请读者提出意见和建议。
