





Joan of Arc

Joan of Arc was a French

the Maid of Orleans. She was a peasant girl of Domfemy in N.E. France. She heard saints' voices urging her to help the dauphin, Charles VII, to regain the throne from the English, who were at the time victorious in the Hundred Years' War. She convinced Charles of her mission, and led a large army

to raise the seige of Orleans. She had Charles crowned at Reims (1429). Later she was captured by the Burgunglans, who sold her to the English. Joan was tried for heresy and sorcery by an ecclesiastical court at Rouen, was condemned, and burnt at the stake. The condemnation was annulled in 1456 and she was canonized in 1920.

圣女贞德

圣女真德是独国的一位民族女英雄,又被称为奥尔曼圣女。她是按圆东北部多僧特的一个取家女儿。她听到圣人的声音,叫她帮助查理七世是太子重新恢复王位。当时,因为英国人在百年战争申获胜而扣压者查理。她就服了查理相信她的债命,带领一丈大军解除了对奥尔展的氛围。她在兰斯为查理进行了加冕(1429)。后来她被布尔贡兰人抓获,他們把她出卖给英国人。 奥德在鲁昂受到一个基督教法庭的审判,因 吳端和巫术被控有罪而被鄉在柱子上燒死。 对她的 算 到于 1456 年宣布作廢,她于 1920 年被率为最大。
