LEARNING SKILLS FOR READING

Why do we read?

There are two main reasons for reading

—Reading for pleasure

—Reading for information

How do we read?

There are two different ways to read a foreign language; depending on your purpose: intensive reading and extensive reading. You will use both at different times. One is slow, careful reading to note the structure of the language and the way words are used so that you can, in turn, use the structures, words, and phrases in sentences of your own. This type of intensive reading is practiced in Part A of each unit. This method of reading is very useful in mastering the basic rules of a language and in learning its idioms. However, this is not rapid fluent reading.

To develop the ability to read rapidly and easily, you need to use a second method—extensive reading. This is rapid reading of a great deal of

easy material. Your main purpose here is not to learn new structures and vocabulary so that you can reproduce them in written and oral work of your own, but rather to understand as quickly and completely as possible the ideas being communicated. In extensive reading you must get used to looking for ideas without analyzing every word and phrase.
