中 同培养一名优秀的运动员需要大运动量的训练一样,学好外语的关键在于大量的语言能力操练,这是尽人皆知的道理。为满足社会上不同层次的英语学习者的不同需要而编写的习题册林林总总、层出不穷,惟独不见专为英语专业的学生编写的练习册。其实英语专业的学生比谁都更需要扎实的语言基础,更需要加强语言技能的训练。虽说任何一种英语专业教材本身都为学生提供不少的练习,但几乎每一所学校英语专业的教师在教学过程中都或多或少会给自己的学生补充一些练习,这说明教科书里的练习总还是显得不足。基于这一考虑,我们编写了这套英语专业一到八级的习题册,分别适用于英语专业本科学生四学年中的八个学期,以利于学生语言能力的进一步培养和提高。

编写这套习题册的依据是教育部 2000 年颁布的《高等学校英语专业教学大纲》。该大纲 对达到二、四、六、八级的学生在语法、词汇,以及听、说、读、写、译各个方面的能力都提出了明确的要求,这套系列习题册便是根据大纲提出的要求来编写的。

关于习题册的使用,我们认为习题册里的练习可以作为课堂教学的一种补充,在课内安排 一定的时间让学生去做,教师进行讲评,也可以让学生在课外做,教师在课内做一定的讲解,当 然也可以完全由学生在课外自行安排时间去做,只要能收到效果便可。但有两点需要提醒,第 一是不要让做练习影响正常的课堂教学,更不能让练习代替了教学,练习是巩固教学内容的一 种手段和方法,是教学的一个重要组成部分,但决不能取代教学本身;第二是不要以应考为目 的去使用这套练习,目前在全国实施的英语专业四、八级考试是检测英语专业教学质量的国家 标准,各地各校都十分重视,学生都力争考出好成绩,我们提倡在日常教学的过程中注意教学 质量,提高教学水平,在考试成绩中得到体现,我们不提倡为应付考试在考前采取题海战术,为 获得考试的好成绩去做练习。

参加这套系列习题册编写的有华东师范大学、上海外国语大学、复旦大学、南京大学等四 所高等院校,编者大多数是具有多年英语专业教学经验的高年资教师,他们对专业学生的水平 和需要最了解,因而他们编写的练习具有较强的针对性。但由于练习的总量较大,编写的时间 比较仓促,书中欠妥、不足、乃至谬误之处在所难免。我们衷心希望使用本习题册的各位老师、 同学不吝指正,以便我们在重印、修订时进一步完善。

序

第二版出版说明

一 等学校外语专业教学指导委员会英语组根据 2000 年教育部批准的《高等学校英语专业 **一** 英语教学大纲》对 1997 年出版的《高校英语专业四、八级考试大纲》作了修订,新的四、 八级考试大纲已于 2004 年 3 月出版,并从 2005 年开始实施。鉴于此,我们感到有必要根据新 的考试大纲对已出版的"外教社英语专业水平测试系列"作相应的修订,重新出版。

在第二版中我们所作的修订主要有以下几方面:

1. 在第 6、7、8 级习题集里编入了 General Knowledge 项目,第 6 级编入了 50 道、第 7、8 两级各编入了 100 道有关英美文学、语言学、英语国家概况方面知识的多项选择题。

2. 根据新考纲中的样卷对习题集中原有的两个 Sample Tests 作了修订,使这些模拟试 卷在内容要求和时间安排上完全符合新考纲的要求;删去了原有的 Skimming and Scanning 部分;在第5、6、7、8级的模拟卷中增加了 General Knowledge 项目。

3. 各习题集均对文字作了勘误和改进。

4. 八级考试中虽然不再包括速读项目,但在阅读部分里对考生的阅读速度依然是有一定要求的,而速读本身是一种重要的阅读技能,是学生在外语学习过程中必须掌握的,所以我们保留了习题集中原有的全部速读练习。我们认为这些练习对学生是有益的。通过大量的实践来提高学生的语言能力是我们编写这套习题集的最终目的。

本习题集由两大部分组成:分类专项练习与模拟试题。

分类专项练习包括听写、听力、语法、词汇、阅读、完型填空、单句翻译及写作,旨在帮助使 用者巩固与提高语言技能和综合运用能力。使用者可按自己的需求和使用时间逐一进行单项 训练,以达到强化训练的目的;使用者还可各项同时练习,每次完成一定的量,循序渐进,达到 综合训练的目的。

模拟试题的设计完全按照《高校英语专业四级考试大纲》的题型与题量编写,只是难度略减,旨在帮助使用者尽早熟悉英语专业四级考试的形式,同时也为全国高等院校英语专业二年级学生或者具有相当水平的学员提供一个台阶,有助于学生/学员了解自己的学习情况,检测自己的英语水平。

本书在编写过程中得到了上海外国语大学博士生导师何兆熊教授的审阅,在此深表谢意。 由于编者水平有限,错误和疏漏都在所难免,恳请同行专家不吝指教,更恳请各位读者不 吝指正。
