修订本前言

本书按照英语专业基础阶段教学大纲所规定的各项要求和 2005 年开始实施的英语专业四级考试新大纲修订编写。根据新的考试大纲,本书就原有考题做了修改和增删。总的来说,新的考卷具有听力难度增大、主观考题增加、而考试时间减少的特点。

多年以来,编者在复旦大学外文系讲授英语专业各门基础课程,对指导和辅导英语专业学生四级考试有丰富经验,并多次参加英语专业四级考试的阅卷工作,在编写此书的过程中,编者特别注重了以下几点:

首先,严格按照教学大纲和考试大纲的规定编写。由于本书是专门为英语专业基础阶段的学生复习迎考而编写的,所以尽量按照最新的考试大纲来编写修订,并参考大纲要求掌握的词汇量和语法知识点,针对基础阶段英语水平测试的特点编排试题,以贴近正式的考试类型和实际的考试水平。

其次,结合中国学生学习英语的特点和英语专业四级的要求,参照历年英语专业四级考试实考题,精心编写了10套模拟试题。其中有不少是根据中国学生学习英语的实际情况来编写的。比如,不少试题结合英语专业实考题目与学生在考试中出现问题较多的题目,经过实际计分,按照正确率的情况,全部予以重新设计编写成题,这样既有了科学性、客观性,又有了实效性,从而有利于学生加强训练,以提高实际考试水平。

同时,本书增加了比较详细的题解,有例句、同义词辨析、语法分析、句型介绍、单词用法等。阅读理解的文章都是选自最新的国外书刊,内容新颖、体裁丰富。作文题目均仿照历年实考题目,参考范文均是我校学生的实际作文,有的是实考作文,但做了修改。每套考题后面还有计分表,便于学生了解英语专业四级考试的内容,并可供学生自己按实际情况填写,做到心中有数。

此外,编者认为,尽管本书试题完全按照历年实考题目编写,是全真模拟题,但是在个别试题或者个别项目里适当地增加了难度,从而让学生从难从严练兵,以达到提高英语实际运用能力的目的。举例来讲,完型填空就适当地增加了难度,以利于学生正确理解全文、补全文章,从而提高他们综合运用语言的能力。

因此,本书在编写过程中既照顾到学生参加英语专业四级考试的实际需要,又照顾到学生学习英语和熟练掌握英语的长远目标,以便达到真正提高学生灵活运用语言实际能力的目的。

在编写过程中,尽管编者字斟句酌,但由于时间仓促和水平有限,差错仍然在所难免,诚恳希望能够得到读者和广大同仁的批评指正。

一、考试时间和内容

英语专业四级考试于每年4月底举行。考试共有6个部分: 1. 听写 2. 听力理解 3. 完形填空 4. 语法及词汇 5. 阅读理解 6. 写作。整个考试需时 130 分钟。

二、考试的类型和题型

- I. 听写(Part I Dictation): 听写文章,全篇约 150 个词,共念 4 遍(语速每分钟 120 字,意群 间隙为 15 秒钟)。要求逐字逐句写出全文。拼写和标点符号正确无误,错误率不超过 8%。考试时间为 15 分钟。
- Ⅱ. 听力理解(Part Ⅱ Listening Comprehension):

Section A: 每题含几组对话(conversations),每组长约200字,共10道选择题。

Section B: 每题为几篇长约 200 字的短文(passages),共 10 道选择题。

Section C: 若干篇 VOA 或 BBC 新闻广播(news broadcast),共 10 道选择题。

每题间隙为5秒钟。语速为每分钟120字。考试时间约15分钟。

- Ⅲ. 完形填空(Part Ⅲ Cloze): 一篇 250 词左右短文中有 20 个空白的选择填空题。填空的词涉及语 法和词汇。考试时间为 15 分钟。
- IV. 语法及词汇(Part IV Grammar and Vocabulary): 30 题有关词汇、短语、语法结构以及基本语法概念的多项选择题。题目中约50%为词汇、词组和短语的用法,约50%为语法结构。考试时间为15分钟。
- V. 阅读理解(Part V Reading Comprehension):

阅读理解(Reading Comprehension)共有数篇短文,总长 1800 个词左右。共 20 题。考试时间 25 分钟。

VI. 写作(Part VI Writing):

Section A: 作文(Composition): 写一篇 200 字左右的短文。作文体裁一般为记叙文、说明文或议论文,要求根据所给的题目和列出的写作提纲或图表、数字统计表等(也附有写作提纲)进行写作。作文内容要切题、完整、条理清楚,文章结构严谨,语法正确,语言通顺恰当。考试时间 35 分钟。

Section B: 便条(Note-writing): 写大约 $50 \sim 60$ 词的通知、便条、请帖等。要求格式正确,语言得体。考试时间 10 分钟。

三、考试的分数和比重

试卷采用百分制,按照各部分的实际得分折算。60分为及格,70分以上为良好,80分以上为优秀。试卷的题型、题数、计分、比重和考试时间列表如下:


