我们根据中学英语教学大纲所附的功能训练具体要求项目,编写了这本《中学英语功能训练》,旨在提供丰富的语言材料,让学习者通过对话形式的实例操练,做到熟能生巧,对所要求的各个项目能自如地表达思想,提高英语交际能力。每一章都有四段对话,文字浅显,符合口语表达的习惯,其中有些对话的难度稍有提高,以满足各种水平的需要。对话附有汉语翻译,便于自学。注释部分着重介绍一些类似的表达方法以及各种表达法的相异之处。每章都有适量的练习,便于学习者检查学习效果。
