

本书将 1997 年至 2005 年的英语专业四级真题按新大纲的结构将题型重新编排,删除了不再考的题型,补充了新题型的样题,充分体现了专业四级考试大纲修改后的新精神。本书可以帮助参加考试的学生了解、熟悉题型,从而达到提高考试成绩的目的。

本书可供大学英语专业学生参加专业四级考试复习之用,也可供教师参考,并可作为参加英语专业四级考试学生的热身练习。

### 前言

为了满足高校英语专业学生学习和参加专业四级考试的需要,我们于 2004 年修订了这本书,目的是为了适应最近颁布的《高校英语专业四级考试大纲》。现在我们再次修订,将 2005 年新大纲实施后的第一次考试试卷加入,并给予解析。

2004年2月高校英语专业四级考试大纲修订小组公布了新的考试大纲和样题。与原来的专业四级考试相比,新的大纲有了很多的变动。首先考试的时间由原来的 140 分钟改为 130 分钟;其次从题型看,听力部分去除了原来的叙述(statement),增加了短文(passage);在阅读理解部分去除了速读(skimming);第三从样题看,难度有所增加,听写的文章比原来的加长了,增加的听力短文也比叙述要困难得多,写作的字数要求也增加了。但是从整体来讲,专业四级考试的题型变化还不大,而且从样题看命题的规律还是与原来的很相似,因而原先的题目还是有很大的参考价值。

为了充分利用原有的考题,本次修订将 1997 年到 2005 年的专业四级真题重新整理编辑。新版将原考卷拆开,删除以后不再考的听力叙述题和阅读中的速读题,按照听写、听力、完形填空、语法与词汇、阅读理解、写作题型组合,以帮助读者集中练习、提高相应题型的答题能力。本次修订增加了 2005 年的考题。

从 2005 年试题看,整体份量增加,难度提高,这对考生来说困难增大,要取得好成绩更难了,这也从另一方面告诉我们,增加练习,尤其是实战练习更有必要。

为了提高考生的应试能力,本书提供了听力材料和详细的答案及答题分析,其中不但讲解了正确答案,而且对其他选项涉及的语法和词义也作了讲解与分析。读者在使用本书的时候可以先自练习答题,然后再对照答案,对于做错的题目读懂讲解内容,达到真正掌握知识的目的。读者可以通过做真题,了解自身不足,提高解题能力,增强临场经验和领会命题意图。在这次修订时,作者再次审视原有的答案,对讲解做了进一步的修改,以达到更完美的境界。为了帮助读者应试,补充原先没有听力短文题的缺陷,本书按照新大纲的要求编写听力短文试题3套,并对样题做了剖析。

为了方便练习本书配有两盒音带,需要说明的是:题目要求听写部分朗读四遍,其中有两遍是逐词或逐词组朗读的,为了节省音带的篇幅,我们改成读两遍,其中一遍是慢读的。

这次修订由郝飞雪和赵宏宇主编,副主编为乔一鸣和闫虹。沈万顺、崔大志、王文玉、赵志梅等老师参加了编写。在本书的编写和修订过程中还得到了美籍教师 Barbara Geisey 女士的热情帮助,在此表示衷心的感谢。

尽管本书已经是第四版,但是书中还可能存在缺点和错误,恳请读者指正。
