编者的话

词汇量是衡量英语水平的重要标志之一。 在英语教学中,我们看到很多学生由于词汇量贫 乏而影响了他们阅读理解和考试答题速度。为 了扩充词汇,一些学生往往急于求成,孤立地背 单词或盲目使用各种词汇强化练习参考书。这 些方法最初可能有一定的效果,但随着词汇量的 增加,多数人会感到负担过重或因枯燥乏味而难 以持续下去,从而降低了学英语的兴趣。

扩大词汇量决非一朝一夕之功,切实可行的办法就是大量地阅读。通过阅读来扩充和掌握词汇,既有助于记住单词本身,又可同时熟悉词的用法和搭配。实践证明,这比孤立地背记单词要好得多。




