本书是供准备报考出国生和研究生的同志使用的英语考试复习指南。作者在第一版的基础上作了大幅度修订。内容包括语法、词汇、阅读理解、汉译英等部分。书中习题主要是针对大学生容易犯的错误和不好掌握的语言点编选的。本书便于读者有系统地复习巩固已学的语法知识、扩大词汇、记忆各种搭配和掌握各种语言现象,有利于做阅读理解等练习,从而提高应试能力。书后附有答案,并对全部语言难点作了比较详细的注释。本书便于自学,又可用作 TOEFL 强化班的效时,是各层次考生理想的考试复习指导材料;还可供高等院校学生、自学英语者以及大学英语教师参考。

修订版前言

本书主要是供准备报考出国生和硕士学位研究生使用的英语复习指导。我们总结多年的教学经验,针对学生在考试中容易犯的错误和不好掌握的语言难点编写了本书,目的是为了帮助读者在较短的时间内,通过大量的练习来熟练地掌握英语中某些重要的语言现象和词汇的基本用法,提高语言综合应用能力和应试能力。

本书自1985年出版以来,深受广大读者的欢迎和赞赏,我们深表感谢。为了满足广大读者的进一步要求,以实现读者对更快提高英语水平的日益强烈的愿望,我们这次对原书作了大幅度修订,在修订本中,既保持了原书的特色,又进一步使语法难点的注释更加系统化,词汇部分更加充实,同时加强了阅读理解部分的练习,使读者能较快、较熟练地掌握一套阅读技巧,以提高对文章的阅读理解能力。

本书上册包括语法练习和词汇练习,力图反映各种句型特点及惯用法,并针对当前学生在词汇方面的弱点,编选了大量词汇练习,尤其是各种词的搭配和同义词辨别等习题。下册编入大量综合性练习(包括辨认错误、综合填充、阅读理解和汉译英等),并附有二套模拟试题,读者可以检验自己复习的效果。此外还将收集1988—1990年研究生英语人学考试试题三套。

书中习题主要参考美国、英国、香港等国家和地区以及国

内有关英语专著及试题集而编著,力求内容丰富、全面,形式 多样。对各种语言现象采取了分类集中编排和综合练习相结 合的形式,以便于读者系统复习和总结,达到切实掌握和记忆。

修订本对全书各部分都作了较详细的注释。对某些重要的语言现象则作了适当的总结和扩充,希望藉此能加深读者对这些内容的理解,并便于具有一定英语水平的读者自学。

书中带有★号的例句均是注释的标志。
