此外,广州外语音像教材出版社还将这套读物灌制成录音带,同时向全国发行。






UNIT THE LODGERS


Ted:

Mrs Yates:

Ted is surprised to see Mark up so early this morning.


It's Saturday today. Mark usually gets up late on Saturdays.

Ted:


Oh, no, you're not. Drink your coffee.

They're coming this morning.


Ted:
