# A Brief Introduction to the TOEFL Examination 托福考试简介

托福(Test of English as a Foreign Language) 测验是由美国音林斯顿教育考试服务处主办的一种考试。测验的目的是考核非英语国家留学生英语水平和 留学生掌握英语的熟练程度,提此决定是否批准留学入学签证。因此它是美国大学及学院求取留学生的唯一合法考试。

托福考试试题为一百五十个,时间为一百一十分钟,内容分三部分。

第一部分: 听力测验 (Listening Comprehension)。试题五十个、时间为四十分钟。目的是测验考生对英语听力的理解能力。

第二部分: 语法结构和书面英语 (Structure and Written Expression)。 试题四十个,时间为二十五分钟。目的是测验语法基本知识的掌握情况和 /5 面表达能力。瀕验内容包括词法和句法。

第三部分、阅读理解能力和词汇 (Reading Comprehension and Vocabulary)。试题六十个、时间为四十五分钟。目 的是测验考生对阅读材料的理解能力和词汇的掌握程度。
