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前　　言

学外语的人最感困难的是记单词，尤其是准备 TOEFL 考试的时候，面对众多、庞杂的单词量，倍感记单词十分枯燥，效率也不高。围绕着提高单词的记忆效率，一些书籍从不同的角度作了阐述，但较缺乏实用性。笔者经过多年教学与实践，总结出一套独到的学习方法，可以称之为“波浪记忆法”。它主要是在心理调节的基础上，有计划地重复、记忆，使记单词的过程不再那么枯燥、乏味，达到渐进、高效、实用的目的。

记单词的过程本身是机械性的，这一单调、重复的特点往往引起人们心理上的焦急、烦躁，记住了后面的，忘了前面的，形成恶性循环，极大地挫伤了学习者的信心和恒心。

从根本上讲，记单词是对外语学习者心理和意志的严峻考验。学习者必须具有明确的学习目的和顽强的毅力，具备良好的心理素质，并不断地进行心理调节，在此基础上，还要有科学的学习方法，使得在最佳的心理状态下，取得最满意的记忆效果。

本书特向读者推荐一种较实用的记单词的方法，它的主要要求如下。

第一，要始终保持最佳的心理状态。记单词的过程实际上就是循序渐进、重复记忆的过程，不能期望简单地念几遍、写几遍就能牢记众多的单词。尤其是出现烦躁心理时，更要时刻提醒自己，要耐心、镇定、有条不紊地坚持学下去。

第二，要有适宜的学习计划。本书推荐的学习进度就是按心理调节原则制定的，该单词书按 30 天强化的时间表安排，

单词分主词条(黑体字)和“联想”词条,后者是前者的同义词。它要求读者用最初几天将全书通读一遍,会的单词划下来,这类单词一般属于“永不忘记”型的。然后进行“波浪联想式记忆”,具体来讲,将第一天需记的单词全部当天记住,第二天开始时先复习第一天的内容,直到全部掌握,再进行第二天的工作量。第三天开始时,又将前两天的内容全部记住,然后开始第三天的工作,以此类推。这样经过 30 天的强化记忆,可使前面的单词重复多达 20 多次,而后的由于刚刚记忆过,因此在应用时,能够达到“记忆犹新”。

当然,随着时间的推移,学习者会感到需要重复记忆的词实在太多,这不要紧,你可以对以前记忆的单词进行筛选,将不易记住的词反复重复,将 30 天再分成几个阶段,进行循环记忆。

上述“波浪联想式记忆法”是一种较好的记单词的方法,它不仅适用于临考前的单词记忆,也可作为平时积累词汇量的手段。今后,无论你面对何种挑战,毅力始终是关键因素。愿广大读者在培养顽强毅力的同时。辅之以科学的记忆方法,使单词的记忆达到令人满意的效果。

由于笔者的经验和水平有限,本书中不妥之处,欢迎有关专家和读者批评指正。
