前 言

为了提高理工科大学生的听、读、写和词汇语法熟练运用能力，并使其尽快熟悉和适应当前的考试方式，我们在对国内外大量资料进行分析研究后，选编了这套《英语系列应试题》。全套书共分五册：《听力理解》、《阅读理解》、《词汇与结构》、《完形填充》和《写作》。各册内容一般按难易程度由浅入深排列，并附有参考答案。另外，第一册——《听力理解》还附有听力材料，并录制有磁带。第五册——《写作》，除有范文、简要说明和注释外，还有培养写作能力的各种基本练习题，如：改错、汉英互译、看图写作等。书中不少材料选自近期从美国归来的选编者所带回的最新资料。题材广泛、内容丰富、实用性强，不失为应试者，特别是要参加大学英语四级考试者应备的一本综合性的好练习。

本套书主要对象是理工科大学生，也可供广大科技工作者及具有同等水平的其他读者提高听、读、写能力，并以备参加各种类型的英语考试时作为综合练习使用。
