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前言

我们编写本书是为大学英语教学提供一种手段，以检验学生通过听力课的教学其听力技能(listening skills)掌握了多少，听的能力又提高了多少。在做听力试题的过程中，学生还可能发现自己的薄弱环节是什么，以便及时训练，加以补救、巩固。从这些意义上说，这本小册子主要是检查性的，同时也是学习性的。

这本试题集还有一个特点，即试题的形式有两种：小对话和短文，这和大多数高等院校的期中、期末考试和全国四级考试的形式一致。坚持做这本听力模拟试题集的练习，一定有助于学生熟悉考试形式。

使用本试题集的教师根据所在学校的具体情况，可在课内安排少量时间使用这本小册子，也可把它用作课外的听

力训练材料,或要求学生自学。不管是哪一种学习方式,都要求学生持之以恒,认真听录音和认真做测试题。最好边听边做习题,中间不要停顿,这样才能比较准确地测出听力水平。此后,必要时学生可以重听第一遍没有听懂的部分。对确实听不懂的部分,教师可作适当的提示或讲解。

本听力模拟试题集共有45份考卷,每一级有15份,可供一学期使用。因此,这本小册子可能要用三个学期,同时配有录音磁带一套。编者希望本试题集有助于提高学生的听力水平。同时由于时间仓促,疏漏之处在所难免,请读者批评指正。
