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### 前言

本注释本原书是美国坦普尔大学弗·弗·艾伦博士专为外国人学习英语而编写的一套系列阅读丛书(一九七四年至一九七八年出齐),适合用作我国高中、大学一、二年级学生及水平相当的同志学习英语的读物。该丛书自八十年代初期起在四川省内外大专院校广泛使用,反映良好。

全书共八册,分初、中、高三级。第一、二、三册为初级,初中毕业即可阅读,第四、五、六册为中级,第七、八册为高级;总词汇范围以三千词为基础。《丛书》语言材料精心编篡,词汇语法严格筛选,课文题材广泛,文体丰富多采,语言生动活泼;每课课文后还附有词汇、语法等练习;书后附有练习答案和词汇表。这套书的趣味性、知识性与科学性融为一体,做到了循序渐进,引人入胜。读者既可培养阅读能力,扩大词汇量,又可较全面地学习语法,逐步提高使用英语的技能。

为了适应中国人学习英语的特点,本注释本对课文、插图说明及练习中出现的生词、习语、重要的人名地名等专有名词,特别是疑难句和重点语法现象均一一作了适当的注释。

本丛书第二册由李明章注释,由于时间仓促,加之本人水平有限,书中可能有错漏之处,希望读者提出宝贵意见,俾于今后改进。
