# 内容简介

正确理解和使用介词,是英语学习中的关键问题之一。本书通过简明的释义和丰富的举例说明英语常用介词的用法,按字母顺序逐一介绍了五十五个介词的意义、搭配和译法,并连带介绍了与之同形的副词、连词等的意义和用法。例句浅明、实用、说明问题,多数选自原文作品,个别地方略作改动。例句之后一律附以汉语译文。本书适合于略有基础的学习者参考之用,既可供作系统学习和复习英语介词的材料,亦可当作英语介词词典使用。

# 前言

介词在整个英语词汇中所占数量不过万分之一,但其活跃的程度却远远超过这个比重。翻开一本英语书,几乎每一两行就可找到一个介词或是与它们同形的副词,在口语中它们尤其活跃,因为大多数的习惯用语(或者说成语)都由它们构成。它们好比是螺丝钉,体积虽小,却到处用得着,要靠它们把机器装配起来,没有它们机器就无法运转。它们本身的意思就比较多,与其他词一搭配,意思就更多,它们对表达思想起着无法估量的作用。不掌握介词的用法就不可能掌握英语。有人说从一个人对介词掌握的情况可以看出他对英语掌握的程度,这话是有一定的道理的。正因为它重要、活跃、有巨大的搭配能力,它对学习英语的人也造成许多困难,尤其是对非本族的人。

为了帮助大家掌握介词的用法,我们编辑了这本《英语介词用法例解》, 对五十五个常用介词作了比较详细的介绍。除了对基本意思加以讲解外, 还列举了一些主要成语。对每一种用法都给了比较多的例句加以说明,有 的给了几十个例句,为的是介绍较多的搭配。多数例句都是从原文作品中 摘选来的,大体上可以反映出现代英语中介词使用的情况。如果能对全书 通读几遍,甚至做一点记忆工作,对掌握介词的基本用法,可望打下一个初 步基础。这样是否就把介词掌握好了呢?还不能这样说,还要下更多功夫。 因为英语中的常用词大多数都和介词有紧密的关系,以动词为例, abide 后 常跟 by abound 后跟 in 或 with, absent 后跟 from, be acquainted 后 跟 with; come 可和介词或与介词同形的副词构成 come about, come across, come up to, come upon 等几十个成语或所谓成语动词。介词 和名词也有密切的联系,以 hand 为例,就可以和介词或与之同形的副词构 成 at hand, at first [second] hand, at the hands of, by hand, in hand, in the hands of, on hand, on one's hand, on the one hand (... on the other), hand in glove with, hand in hand, hands up, ask for one's hand, from hand to mouth, fall into the hands of, get the upper hand of, get out of hand, have a hand in, join hands with, keep one's hands off, lay hands on, try one's hand at 等几十个成语。因此还要结合每一个常用词去学习。此外还要通过大量实践去体会介词在英语中是如何活用的。经过长时期的努力才可能真正掌握好介词的用法。

尽管如此,集中钻研一下主要介词的用法还是必要的,它可以帮助你了解这些介词的基本意思,可以看到一些重要搭配及成语,这对今后学习英语会有一定的好处。

在浩如烟海的词汇中常用动词和介词可以说是两股主流,所以我们首 先要掌握它们的用法。在此基础上再掌握其他常用词的用法就会比较容易 了。如果能掌握一万左右积极词汇的用法,对英语可以说打好了坚实基础, 进行专业的外语工作困难就会比较小了。

由于介词大多数都有与之同形的副词,这些词和介词同样活跃有用,因 此在本书中也一并加以介绍,有个别介词还有同形连词,这里也附带讲了 一下。

本书所收常用介词一律按字母顺序编排,各项意义、用法、搭配,以及同形副词、连词等的意义和用法,都加了醒目的标题,目的是为了便于查阅。所以本书除了可以供作系统学习和复习的参考材料之外,还可以当作一本英语介词词典使用。

为了编写本书,搜集和整理资料曾花了不少功夫,但是研究还是不够深入的。词义的选择和归纳难免不带一些主观性,处理的详简程度也未必恰当。热诚盼望读者对本书不足不妥之处加以批评指正。

  - 1) 和某些动词连用:

I want to consult you. It's about Xiao Li. 我想跟你商量一下,是关于小李的事。

He could not make out what it was all about. 他搞不清这都是怎么回事。

What did she say about this question? 这个问题她怎么说?

Did he say anything about what to do? 他说没说该怎么办?

Has she told you about it? 这事她告诉你了吗?

What are you two talking about? 你们俩在谈什么?

He began to ask her about herself. 他开始问她自己的情况。

My aunt has often spoken to me about you. 我姑姑常和我说起你。

What have you been thinking about? 你在想什么?

I read about it in the paper. 这事我在报上读到过。

They chatted about all kinds of things. 他们天南地北谈了许多。 He wanted to know about the political situation there. 他想了解那里的政治形势。

She did not argue further about it. 她没有再进一步辩论此事。

She went about her business of preparation. 她着手做准备工作。 Then we went about our respective tasks. 然后我们就各自着手执 行我们的任务。

Do you know how to go about it? 你知道这事该怎样进行吗? Jennie went about her work, but the impression persisted. 贞妮干着她的活,但这印象一直在她脑中萦回。

All that afternoon he went about his work fretfully. 整个下午他工作得很不耐烦。

I will see about it. 这事我来处理。

You ought to go about more. 你应该多出来走走。

They strolled about for a time. 他们到各处蹓了一会儿。

He looked at the people walking about. 他看着来回走着的人。

I have been about a good deal in this part. 这一带我跑过不少地方。

The little ducks were swimming about in the pond. 小鸭子在池塘里游来游去。

The purple butterflies fluttered about visiting each flower in turn. 紫色的蝴蝶来回翻飞,一会儿停在这朵花上,一会儿停在那朵花上。

There were few people about. 附近没有多少人。

Have you finished typing it? —I'm just about to. 你打(字打)完了 吗? ——就要打完了。

This brought about a crisis within the Labour Movement. 这引起了工人运动内部的一场危机。

A rumour has got about that he is going to resign. 有谣言说他准备辞职。

The rumor was already about. 这谣言已经传开了。

◇ leave (things) about 把(东西)随便乱放[扔]

Don't leave your things about. 别把东西到处乱扔。

He is always leaving his toys about. 他老是把玩具随便乱扔。

◇ order something about 随便使唤人

Now there was no one to *order him about*. 现在没有人随便支使他了。

He didn't want to be ordered about. 他不愿意受人支使。

◇ put oneself about [be put about] 发愁

He told her that it was useless for her to put herself about. 他告诉她发愁没有用。

I was much put about. 我很发愁。

◇ about turn [face] 向后转

About turn! 向后转!

1. 在…上方

The room was in darkness except for the solitary light above his desk. 房里一片黑,只有他书桌上方有一盏孤零零的灯。

Above it hung an oil painting by Beryl. 在它上方挂着一幅贝列耳的油画。

The flowers formed an archway above their heads. 在他们头的上方花从形成了一个拱门。

The moon was now above the trees in the east. 月亮这时在东边那些树的上方。

# 2. 在…以上,比…高

It weighs above [over] ten tons. 它的重量超过十吨。

The population of this city is above a hundred thousand. 这座 城市的人口超过十万。

The temperature was only a degree above zero. 气温这时只有零上一度。

Above 200 people were there. 有二百多人在那里。

All children above six years of age must go to school. 六岁以上小孩都得上学。

Qinghai lies 3,196 metres above sea-level. 青海海拔三千一百九十六公尺。

Autumn crops have been harvested. Yields were above last year's. 秋冬作物已经收割,产量超过去年。

They decided to raise the purchase price slightly above the basic price. 他们决定把收购价格提到比基价稍高一点。

Their unemployment rate has gone into double digits, above 10 per cent. 他们的失业率已经达到两位数字,超过了百分之十。

Output of most of the products is above that for last year. 大多数产品的产量都比去年高。

Last year the average income per household was 470 yuan, 70 per cent above the 1978 figure. 去年每户的平均收入为四百七十元,比一九七八年提高百分之七十。

#### 3. 超过,超越

You're far above me in every way. 你在各方面都比我强得多。

Well, this sort of talk is above me. 嗯,这样的报告我听不懂。

It was above my means. 这我买不起。

In a class society there is no human nature above classes. 在阶级社会里没有超阶级的人性。

#### 4. 用于成语:

# ◇ be above [doing] something 不会(做出某事)

He is above meanness and deceit. 他不会做出卑鄙骗人的事。

She is above personal grudges. 她是不会记恨人的。

I should think that you would be above anything like that. 我想你是不会做出这样事的。

He really is unselfish and above small jealousy and hatred. 他的确没有私心,没有妬忌人记恨人那种小心眼。

Do you think they are above doing such a thing? 你认为这种事他们会干不出来?

# ◇ be above something 超出…之外,不容

One could not be above the battle, one must fight it out. 我们不能超然于战斗之外,得打到底。

He was above all nervousness. 他丝毫也不紧张。

His conduct has always been above suspicion. 他的行为从没有什么可怀疑之处。

They all thought he was above reproach. 他们都认为他没有什么可责难之处。

#### ◇ above all 首先,特别是

Above all he was a first-rate mathematician. 他首先是一个第一流的数学家。

The question of the intellectuals is above all one of ideology. 知识分子的问题首先是思想问题。

But above all tell me quickly what I have to do. 但首先赶快告诉我我该怎么办。

Workers, above all, will know how to approach the problem correctly. 特别是工人会知道该怎样正确对待这个问题。

I enjoyed all the school subjects, but history above all. 所有课程我都很喜欢,特别是历史。

What I need, above all things, is criticism. 我最最需要的是批评意见。

Above all things he wanted to be decent in his treatment of people. 他最希望的是宽厚待人。

He longed, above everything, to have a heart-to-heart talk with them. 他最盼望的是能和他们说说心里话。

Above, there were four men to a bedroom. 楼上一间卧室住四个人。
