前　　言

在学习英语的过程中，我们会经常遇到许多形似而义异或义近的词语。在结构上，这些词语具有非常微妙的差异，有的在于所用冠词或介词的不同，有的在拼法上仅差一字之微。在涵义上，它们有的相互接近，有的却大相径庭，令人难以捉摸，很易引起混淆。我们碰到这类词语时，必须仔细分辨它们的拼法和用法，透彻地辨析其词义和词性，决不能不求甚解，否则应用时会犯“张冠李戴”的毛病，写出似是而非、不知所云的文句。因此，对英语学习者来说，注意分辨相似词语的区别是颇为重要的。

本书收集了六百多组常见的英语相似词语，先指出其异同和易于混淆之处，然后说明其涵义和用法。每组词语附有适当的例句，以便读者比较和参考。

本书的内容分为下列五大类：

(一) 形似而义异的单词的比较。如：affect和effect; beside和besides; especially和specially; farther和further; hard和hardly; lifelong和livelong; machine和machinery; moral和morale; sometime和sometimes等。

(二) 同义词和近义词的比较。如：act和action; adventure和venture; alive和living; autumn和autumnal; avenge和revenge; born和borne; burned和burnt; correction和correctness; decided和decisive; drunk和drunken; electric和electrical; gold和golden; sick和sickly; skilled和skilful; west和western等。

(三) 同形异义词和同音异义词的比较。如: always 和 all ways; anyway 和 any way; a piece 和 a piece; China 和 china; everyday 和 every day; however 和 how ever; its 和 it's; maybe 和 may be; recover 和 re-cover; sometime 和 some time; need (regular v.) 和 need (modal v.) 等。

(四) 相似词组的比较。如: a number of 和 the number of; as it was 和 as it were; before long 和 long before; behind time 和 behind the times; after an hour 和 in an hour; in the morning 和 on the morning; no more... than 和 not more... than; out of question 和 out of the question; take a chair 和 take the chair 等。

(五) 相似语句的比较。如: cannot do it 和 cannot but do it; forget to post the letter 和 forget posting the letter; I don't like to go there 和 I don't like going there; I have my hair cut 和 I have cut my hair; So do I 和 So I do; This building is in repair 和 This building is under repair 等。

本书的一个特点是, 它能经常通过一对词语的比较以说明其他同一类型的相似词句。例如通过 at table 和 at the table 的比较, 说明 go to school 和 go to the school 的区别; 通过 drink 和 drinking 的对比, 说明 smoke 和 smoking 的差异; 通过 hear 和 listen 的辨异, 说明 see 和 look 的关系; 通过 hear 和 hear of 的对照, 说明 know 和 know of 的差别; 通过 few 和 a few, 说明 little 和 a little; 通过 cups full 和 cupfuls, 说明 mouths full 和 mouthfuls; 通过 instructive 和 instructional, 说明 informative 和 informational; 通过 We stood waiting 和 We

waited standing, 说明 We sat reading all the evening 和 We read sitting all the evening... , 使读者在阅读了一组例句的比较之后，能触类旁通，由此悟彼地联想到其他类似词语的关系和区别。因此，本书虽列举了六百多组相似词句，实质上它们却代表了成千上万对与之具有类似差别的词语。

笔者编写本书共用了近十年的时间。在编写过程中，参考了英、美、日、苏等国四十多部书籍和辞典。主要的参考书为：
