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三、本词典释义有三种情况。一种是一般含义,例如 abandon 一词作 "放弃、 抛弃" 解; market 一词作 "市场" 解; mecount 一词作"帐、帐目……"解,等等。这种释义与一般英汉董事不同 之处是本词典的加注内容偏向于财贸各行业用语。这部分种义主要 是适应中等院校师生以及学习英语时间还不长的各方面 人 员 韵 需 要。另一种是各行业的专业用语,即行话。例如 abandon 一词作 "(保险业用语) 委付"解; market—词作"销路; 行情、行市" 解; position 一词作"(银行、金融业用语)头寸"解等. 这种 释义使读者对它们的使用范围一目了然,避免在运用时张冠李戴而 出差错。第三种也是各行业的专业用语,但这种释义是本词典所特 有的,是当前国内已出版的其他工具书和参考书中不具备的。它们 · 乃是近几十年来随着科技突飞猛进和社会的发展而出现 的 旧 词 新 义。例如 adandon 一词作"(运输业用语)中止(航运)"解; account 一词当动词用时作"结算;处理"解; market一词作 "(交 易所、行情报道用语)市场人士"解等等。以上第二和第三种释义是 本词典的特点, 特别是第三种释义是作者多年的科研成果.

四、本词典所收词目,有国际贸易、国际金融、运输、保险、银行、商检、海关、港务、会计等等行业的用语,除一般词语外,也包括大量缩略语和专有名词,除常用的旧词外,也包括近几十年来随

着社会的发展而出现的新词.

五、本词典所收自然词词目有6000条左右,连同列在词目内部的派生词和复合词共为10000余条,此外,还收缩略语约1000余条, 专有名词约1000余条,因此实际收词可达12000—13000条。

六、列在词目内部的派生词,凡易于理解的一般不再分别释义 或予以加注. 在有关词目中,本词典还收有习语数百条. 同时,还 收有外来语几十条.

七、本词典所用括号有四种情况。一种是括号内的纯属解释性词语。例如:(法律用语),(尤指限制进口政策)等等。第二种是括号内的词语是可以有也可以没有的。例如。期货(交易),可理解为期货,也可理解为期货交易。第三种是括号内的词语可与括号前的词语、使用意思不变。例如。 to have pleasure in doing (to do) sth. 可理解为 to have pleasure in doing sth.,也可理解为 to have pleasure to do sth. 第四种情况是括号内的词语与括号前的词语可替换使用,但意思有所不同。例如:裁定某人(某事),可理解为裁定某人,也可理解为裁定某事。

八、本词典所用"/"符号有三种情况。一种是该符号前后两个词可替换使用,意思不变。例如: to have/take pleasure,可理解为to have pleasure,也可理解为to take pleasure.第二种是该符号前后两词同时使用,表示相反或不同意思。例如: vanning/devanning.第三种是该符号仅用来分隔两个例句,无任何其他作用或意思.
