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前 言

这是为大学生编写的一套教材。起点是中学毕业水平，即学过几年英语，已掌握 600—1000 词汇，有初步的语法概念，但缺乏听说训练。本书着重练好语言基本功，强调听说，介绍主要的语法项目。本书（包括上、下册）学完后可达到 2000 词汇，有初步语法基础，有一定表达能力。由于强调听说，我们全书作以下安排：

1. 课文：

每课有两篇课文，一般短小精悍，在 100—200 个单词之间。文字平易，易于上口，所包含的基本上都是常用词汇，以利于打好语言基础。一般都体现本课的语法项目，使有助于掌握该项语法。我们要求把每篇课文复述下来，即在反复听录音的基础上，把课文都背下来，而且要反复复习，在脑中留下深刻印象，使词汇及语法都在脑中扎根，这样学习才能巩固，才能经久不忘。课文是一课之本，要得到最大的重视。语法词汇主要通过课文来掌握，孤立的句子和词汇要牢牢记住是困难的。本书课文短，文字平易就是为了要复述背诵。我们的原则是调子要低一些（过难即难以接受，达不到记牢学透的目的），但要求要高一些（要把课文全部背下来，单词都能拼写，当然还要正确理解），充分发挥课文的主干作用。

2. 句型练习：

每课配有四段句型练习，主要帮助掌握本课的语法项目，熟练技巧。句型一般都是换字练习，即换几个字构成新句子，通过同一句式的练习，达到对一些语法结构的熟练掌握。这是一种机械式的练习，即照句样子造句，没有多少创造的余地，但这对初学者有好处，比较容易做，可比较精确，容易留下较深印象，逐步达到活用目的。不掌握足够的语言材料，要活用要创造都是困难的。只有对基本句型有了熟练的掌握，自由表达思想才有可能。

3. 对话：

每课有两段对话，一般都比较简短，从四五个来回到七八个来回。短才容易记住，长了看了后面忘了前面，难收巩固之效。对话于课文是一种补充，可介绍更多语言材料，也是一个桥梁，通向更灵活的口语活动，它的地位仅次于课文，应得到充分的重视。一般也和本课的语法项目相结合，有助于掌握各项语法。在反复听录音的基础上，应尽量把每段话都背下来。

4. 练习：

每课一般有六个练习，长短不等。问答练习主要帮助消化巩固课文，同时培养应对能力，也帮助掌握问句结构。题下都给出答案，以利自学。学员可先自己答再看答案，动过脑筋的印象会深一些。还有一些语法练习，帮助掌握语法结构，培养表达能力，从中也可学到一些词汇。最后一般是一个笔头练习。其他练习，根据学员的时间，有些也可笔头做。除此之外，教师还可根据需要增加一些练习，练习量作现在的安排，是照顾多数学员的实际情况，太多会造成负担，太少又难以巩固。教师和学员可根据实际需要和可能作灵活

处理。

5. 语音：

我们避免了过去编教本时先安排一个语音阶段的做法。过去那样做是有道理的，先教音标，甚至介绍发音理论，帮助掌握发音要领，能起一定作用。但现在情况变了，有了录音机，这就为从感性入手创造了条件。我们的做法先不讲理论，也不介绍音标，而是强调模仿，在有相当基础后再介绍音标及必要理论，发展读音能力。根据几年的经验，这样做效果更好一些。再者，一般中学生都学过音标，先不讲也没有太大关系，只要充分利用录音带，语音语调问题可自然得到解决。

6. 语法：

本书介绍了大部分重点语法，上册(前16课)着重介绍五种基本时态，下册(后16课)介绍另一些常用时态、被动时态、语气、比较级和不定式、动名词、分词等。有了这样的语法基础，进行阅读和听说实践都基本上可以应付。在此基础上再看一本系统语法，语法观念就比较清楚了。掌握语法的关键在于实践，语法条条知道得很多，却一用就错，就谈不上掌握语法。语法主要是用来指导实践的，我们强调语法在实践中的应用，实践中到处都贯串着语法，实际掌握提高了，语法也就学到手了。不宜过分强调语法理论，更不宜把结构搞得过细，不要为语法而语法。

7. 词汇：

本书包含了约2000个词汇，都是最常用词汇。掌握了这些词汇，可以阅读一般的简写读物，进行简单的英语会话，能勉强和说英语的人交流思想。但这只是一个初步基础，在

此基础上可进一步扩大词汇量，在深度和广度上进一步提高对词汇的掌握。若能把词汇量扩大到5000左右，并有较好的掌握，可以担任一般的外语工作。当然词汇是一片海洋，学一辈子也难说对词汇已掌握到家。但良好的开端很重要，通过对头2000词汇的学习可掌握拼法规律，接触到一些主要的词汇现象，有此基础，进一步登堂入室就有了条件。

对本书的使用可根据对象的不同有不同的方法。英语专业学生学习，要求要高一些。要给予充分的时间，反复巩固，做到百分之九十以上的材料都吸收。如每周一课，至少要六课时，全书一年学完（与之配合还可补充其他材料）。如每周学两课，约需12课时，全书可半年学完。公共英语学生要求可以略低一点。他们每周仅有四五小时的上课时间，可以考虑一周上一课，一年学完。如时间太紧，可以抓住重点，能吸收百分之七、八十也就不错了。自学的人情况各不相同，各人可根据自己情况作现实的安排。应争取每周学一课，学完以后还可总的复习一次，大体上在一年中学完。

本书学完后，可接学《现代英语》，该书将与本书同时出版。学本书有困难的学员，可先学《英语入门》，该书也将同时出版。这些书构成一个互相配合的有机整体，称为《大学英语序列教程》。全书都将配有录音带和录像带，我们相信这套教材将为大学的英语教学创造有利的条件。
