前言

英语学习者往往为听不懂正常语速的美国英语而感到苦恼:其实听不懂的原因,大多是由于学习者竭力想听清每一个字,结果"拣了芝麻丢了西瓜",总的意思反而忽略了。本书练习的指导思想即是帮助学习者克服纠缠于个别字句的积习学会根据实际情况抓住说话内容的主要意思。本书的使用者通过反复听,反复练,必能迅速提高自己的听力水平:同时,通过模仿,还能提高自己的口语水平。

本书的听力训练共分二十个单元,每个单元 由一段对话和若干配图练习组成。对话情景均选 自日常生活,录音采用正常语速,语言生动活泼, 练习实用性强,毫无一般听力材料难免的矫饰与 斧凿之弊。使用者可以一个人边看图,边听录音, 边做练习;还可以和别人一起看图提问、复述或 讨论。总之,本书对于学习当代美国英语,提高 英语听和说的能力不失为一本设计新颖,程度适 中,趣味性强,实用有效的理想教材,它不仅适 合于我国大、中学校学生和广大英语自学者,而 且也可用作英语听说课教材。

为帮助使用者透彻理解本书听力练习的内容, 编译者特提供声带的全部文字材料,并配上必要 的注解和参考译文。所有的练习都有参考答案。 为便利使用者检索,目录上各英文篇目后面均加 注中文。

由于编译者水平有限,有些注解和译文内容 可能有不妥之处,恳请使用者批评指正。




