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
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前言

为了帮助参加大学英语六级考试的考生系统地理解、掌握考试的重点词汇及考点,我们精心编写了这本融"自测、考点、过关"于一体的新型参考书。全书共分为50个单元,每个单元由三个相互关联而又彼此独立的部分组成:

"自测"部分有 10 道考题,它是对考生原有知识的回顾和检验。通过做这个练习,考生可以找出自己的薄弱环节,从而确定自己下一步学习的主攻词汇。

"考点"词汇是本书的核心部分。我们根据多年的教学经验和历届考题,从《大学英语教学大纲通用词汇表(5~6级)》中精选出1296个重点词汇,并对其进行了比较全面、系统的讲解。为帮助读者准确地理解掌握词汇的意义和习惯搭配,我们给所有的词汇均加了例句。所选例句规范地道、搭配典型、内容新颖,充分体现了常用题型中的考点。此外,为了便于读者记忆,凡是在例句中出现的考点词汇及其相关词组,我们均以斜体对其进行标识。考生在"自测"部分中遇到的各种问题,在这一部分都可以找到令人满意的解答。

"过关"部分是对考生学习情况的验收和巩固, 也是对"自测"题的补充和完善。这一部分习题可进 一步帮助考生全面复习"考点"中所出现的词汇,以 巩固所学内容,加深印象。

本书的显著特点是:

①选词实用。编者去粗取精,精选常考词汇,取舍合理。②分块记忆。把 1296 个词分成 50 个单元,每天一个单元,考生在不到两个月的时间内便可掌握这些词汇,极大地方便了自学。③重视理解和运用。融"自测、考点、过关"于一体,通过反复练习,帮助考生强化记忆。

书中大部分习题选自全真试题和模拟试题,少数为编者新编写的。这些习题体现了六级考试的特点和动态,能帮助考生熟悉考试要求,掌握做题技巧,全面复习巩固考试中常用的词汇、短语和语法结构。

由于编写时间仓促等原因,书中不足之处,恳请 读者批评指正。

Statistics tell part of the story. 统计资料说明了部分问题。

Statistics is a branch of mathematics. 统计学是数学的一个分支。

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
