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内 容 简 介

本书是根据国家教委颁发的《大学英语教学大纲》的规定，并参考考试大纲以及 1996 年 7 月公布的《关于公布大学英语四、六级考试第二批新题型的通知》中的样题编写的。

全书共十一部分。第 1—9 部分为大学英语六级考试各单项训练模拟题，每个部分包括 10 套形式与正式考试题相同的练习题，每项练习的分数与目前的统考分数相同，以便考生进行计时计分单项自测。其中，第 3、4、5、6 部分是新题型，即：听写填空、复合式听写、简短回答题和阅读与翻译。第 10 部分为练习题答案，第 11 部分为听力书面材料。本书对参加六级考试的学生有较大帮助。

前　　言

全国大学英语四、六级考试委员会于 1996 年 7 月首次推出了六级考试将采用的四种新题型：听写填空，英译汉，简短回答题及复合式听写。其具体要求如下：

1. 英译汉 (Translation from English into Chinese)：“英译汉安排在阅读理解部分之后。每次考试共 4 至 5 题。从阅读理解部分的 4 篇文章中分别选择 1 至 2 个句子组成 1 题，每篇文章有 1 至 2 题。考试时间为 15 分钟。考试时，考生可以参阅阅读理解部分的有关文章，以便了解下文。”

2. 听写填空 (Spot Dictation)：“听写填空安排在听力理解部分之后。试卷上给出一段 120 词左右的短文，其中有 10 个左右空格。每个空格要求填入一个句子，或者句子的一部分。全文以大学英语教学大纲规定的语速朗读三遍。第一遍全文朗读，没有停顿，供考生听懂全文内容；第二遍在空格后有停顿，要求考生把听到的内容（句子或句子的一部分）填入空格；第三遍同第一遍一样没有停顿，供学生进行核对。听写填空所用短文的题材、体裁和难度等与听力理解部分的听力篇章相同。听写填空录音和听力理解题录音制作在同一磁带上。”

3. 简短回答题 (Short Answer Questions)：“简短回答题安排在阅读理解之后。每次考试为一篇文章，文章后有 5 个问题或不完整的句子。要求在阅读文章之后用简短的英语（可以是句子，也可以是单词或短语）回答所提的问题或补足不完整的句子。考试时间为 15 分钟。”

4. 复合式听写 (Compound Dictation)：“复合式听写安排在听力理解部分之后。试题由两个部分组成：第一部分是听写单词，要求考生在空格中填入所缺单词；第二部分是表达，要求考生根据所听内容写出要点。全文是一篇 250 词左右的短文，朗读三遍。第一遍是全文朗读，没有停顿，要求考生注意听懂全文内容。第二遍朗读时，第一部分在每个空格之后略有停顿，让考生填入所缺单词，第二部分之后停顿 5 分钟，让考生根据所听到的内容写出主要意思。第三遍同第一遍一样，没有停顿，供考生进行核对。考试时间为 15 分钟。复合式听写旨在考核学生的听的能力，拼写能力，记笔记能力和书面表达能力。”

显而易见，六级考试题型的调整，增加了主观题的比重，其目的是“促使各校把精力放在正常课堂教学上，扎实提高学生的实际英语能力”。同时，也加大了六级考试的难度。考生除了按照教学大纲的要求认真学好课内外指定的学习教材外，考前有目的有针对性地熟悉考试题型并作一定数量的模拟训练题会有助于考生在考试过程中更好地发挥自己的实际英语水平，顺利地通过六级考试。

为了帮助广大准备参加大学英语六级统考的考生熟悉考试题型，尤其是新题型，并在较高的要求下能积极主动，富有成效地学习，更好地把握考试要求，获得好成绩，我们以新教学大纲和根据新教学大纲制定的考试大纲为依据，按照教委 1996 年 7 月颁布的样题为标准，并结合我们在长期英语教学、考前辅导、阅卷实践中的经验，编写了这本新题型模

拟训练题集。

本书编集了目前大学英语六级考试所采用的所有题型。全书共十一部分，第一至九部分为大学英语六级考试各单项训练模拟题，即：(1) 对话听力，(2) 短文听力，(3) 听写填空，(4) 复合式听写，(5) 简短回答题，(6) 阅读与翻译，(7) 词汇与结构，(8) 改错，(9) 作文。每个部分包括 10 套形式与正式考试题相同的练习题，每项练习的分数与目前的统考分数相同，以便考生进行计时计分单项自测。其中，第三、四、五、六部分是新题型。第十部分为练习题参考答案。第十一部分为听力书面材料。

另外，我们还为听力部分配备了录音磁带 5 盘，由外籍教师 Martin Jensen 和 Soledad Gili 录制。

由于编者水平有限，时间仓促，错误和不妥之处在所难免，衷心希望广大读者批评指正。
