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## 说 明

高中生欲提高英语程度，有效的方法是多读，这一点是不言而喻的。可是，程度较差的人难耐一一查辞典之劳，很多人都半途而废了。而读中英对照读物又往往有很多人会不读原文转而去读译文。考虑到这一点，为了使大家能不查辞典也能顺利地读下去，我们请东京学艺大学的宫内秀雄名誉教授、鹤见大学的宫田幸一教授、主教大学的伊藤健三教授为编委，编出了这套系列泛读读本。首先，这个读本选择的文章都较易懂，饶有趣味，难懂之处都已改写得较为浅显。文章的右边按 ABC 顺序列出了原文中出现的所有单词，并加上了中文释义。必要之处还加有脚注作语法说明，并且有参考译文。这样大家不用查辞典，却可获频频查辞典之效，必然会使大家具备对单词的丰富知识。为了加深大家对英语文章的理解，我们还增加了补注、测验题和高考参考试题。我们相信，熟读本系列丛书之后，您的英语程度会大大提高。

## 前 言

本书是专为高中各年级的同学们泛读而编写的。

统观高中生的英语学习，一年内就那么一、二本教科书，自始至终都是学习结构如何、什么词性、修饰关系又怎样，真是一丝不苟。当然，并非说这不对，但不能因此而忘记要更广泛地接触英语。简单说来，前者叫精读，后者为泛读。这两者犹如车子的两个车轮，只有两者并进，才能达到预期的目的。

至于甚么样的文章适合于泛读，这一点也许各有不同看法，但我认为下面三点是选择的标准。(1) 程度比自己的水平低一点的；(2) 内容方面有趣且健康的；(3) 篇幅不太长的。

本书中收录的三篇就最具备这些条件。我确信是最适合于泛读的文章。

注释方面，尽量注意到直译和意译并重。希望同学们通过直译习惯于英语本身，借着意译体会英语的本意。另外，也许要求有点过高，就是采取 English through English (通过英语学习英语) 的方针。这完全是想发挥泛读的作用。

## 作者和作品

作者 Oscar Wilde (奥斯卡·王尔德) 于距今 100 多年前的 1854 年 10 月 16 日出生于爱尔兰的首都都柏林。

父亲 William Wilde 是眼科医生, 同时对考古学、历史也有颇深的造诣。母亲 Jane Francesca 具有优秀的文学和语言学才能, 是个善于社交的女作家, 以其笔名 Spernanza 而闻名。Oscar 的文采、社交才能也许是受到这种家庭环境的熏陶所致。

1874 年, Oscar 20 岁时, 以优异的成绩毕业于都柏林的三一学院, 接着进了牛津大学。在这里, 他从 Ruskin (罗斯金) 和 Pater (佩特) 那里受到的影响可以说左右了他的一生。

Oscar 的理想是艺术化的生活, 享乐的人生。他的愿望就是将艺术作为手段, 最大限度地享受人生的欢乐。因此, 从一般尊崇中庸的英国人看来, 他竟敢穿着奇装异服在伦敦市中心漫步。他的爱好和思维方法也极为奇特, 与众不同, 并因此而出了名, 甚至连好奇心强的美国人也曾两次邀请他去美国进行旅行讲学。

但是, 1895 年的一件诉讼案揭露了他的不端行为, 被判处两年徒刑。这使他从此一蹶不振, 于 1900 年 11 月 30 日在巴黎的一家旅馆里咽下了最后一口气。

本书收录的三篇是他具有代表性的短篇童话。三篇都是以人类的美好幻想和哀愁; 人类朴素的爱情和纯真的情感为题材。在其简明、优美的笔调方面, 较 Grimm (格林) 和 Andersen (安徒生) 等人都有过之而无不及。
