# 前 言

在英语中,介词的用法很多,又可以与其它词构成短语,搭配关系既复杂又灵活。如何掌握这些介词及其短语的用法,是我们学习英语时常遇到的一个难题。为了帮助大学生、中学生、及广大学习英语的同志排除这一障碍,我们编写了这本书,介绍一些常用介词及这些介词与动词构成的短语的用法。

本书主要选了常用介词20个,介绍了每个介词的常用含意,并附有例句,收入563条动词与介词构成的短语,每条动词短语之后都附有两个例句,以帮助读者掌握这些短语的用法。

本书对介词及其动词短语的释义采用英汉双解,例句选 自英文书报刊物及教科书,并参考了国内外 出 版 的英 语辞 典。

由于编者水平有限,本书一定存在着缺点及错误, 敬请读者批评指正。

- 1. around, on every side of 在周围,在四面八方
- a) Electrons move about the nucleus of cach atom. 电子围绕着每个原子核运动。
- b) Everything about me was so beautiful. 我周围的一切都是那样美好。
- c) Her hair hangs about her neck. 她的发垂于 颈际。
- d) He planted trees about the house. 他在房子 四周种上了树。
- e) They crowded about him. 他们围住了他。
- 2. near; not far from; determining approximately time, size or quantity 大约,差不多,左右
- a) This table is about the size of that one. 这张工作台大小与那张的差不多。
- b) There are about 500 TV sets in our university。 我们学校里大约有500台电视机。
- c) The tungsten filament can be heated to about 5,100°F. 这钨丝可以加热到华氏5.100度左右。
- d) Tomorrow about this time I shall be here。 明天大约这个时候我在这儿。
- e) Facts show that the Chinese were able to

- a) He wants to know something about the teaching machine. 他想了解一些有关教学机的事情。
- b) John asked Mary about the size of the new machine. 约翰询问了玛丽 有关这台机器的尺寸。
- c) I was speaking to him about my plan。 我在跟他说我的计划。
- d) Tell me all about the operation of the lathe。 请把有关车床操作的全部情况都告诉我。
- e) What have you been busy about? 你们一直 在忙什么?

# phrases: V. + about 短语动词

- advise about/on: to give (someone) advice about (something or doing something) 商量
  - a) Will you please advise me about which book to buy? 你看我是买那一本书好?
  - b) A broker will advise you about how to invest your money. 经纪人和你商量怎样投资。
- argue about/over to disagree or quarrel about (something or doing something) 争论,讨论

- a) They are always arguing about unimportant matter. 他们总是在争论不重要的事情。
- b) Bob and Mary argued about having a party. 巴布和玛丽讨论开晚会的事情。
- arrange about: to make a plan concerning; organize about (something or doing something) 协商
  - a) We must arrange about that. 我们应协商解决那件事情。
- ask about: to request information concerning (something or someone) 询问,打听
  - a) The director is asking about those papers that you promised to have ready. 主任在询问你答应准备的那些文章呢。
  - b) When I saw John yesterday, he asked about you. 我昨天见到了约翰,他打听你了。
- bang about:

  - a) The children banged about the house all afternoon and I couldn't rest at all. 孩子们整个下午都在房子里吵吵闹闹,我一点都不能休息。
  - b) A door was banging about somewhere and the child could not get to sleep. 近处有门关关

开开的响声使得小孩睡不着。

- 2. to travel in different parts of (a place) 常 到 (某地) 闲逛,
- a) My uncle has been banging about Africa for years. 我叔叔一直在非洲游历了好些年。
- b) He was then banging about the square. 他 当时正在广场闲逛。
- boast about/of: to speak too proudly of (one's abilities, successes or possessions) 吹嘘
  - a) He is always boasting about being the best story-teller in his class. 他总是吹嘘 他是班 级里最会讲故事的人。
  - b) The hero never boasted about his brave deeds. 这位英雄从来没有吹嘘过他的勇敢行为。
- bother about: to take trouble concerning (something or someone) 麻烦,烦扰
  - a) Don't bother me about that trifle. 不要为那件琐事打扰我了。
  - b) Let's don't bother about cooking tonight. We can eat out. 今晚我们不必费事做饭了。我们到外面吃去。
- brag about/of: to speak too proudly of (one's abilities, successes, possession) 自夸, 白吹
  - a) He does not brag about his achievements. 他不自吹他的成就。
  - b) Peter bragged about having got the highest

grade. 彼得自吹说得到了最高的分数。

brood about/over: to worry about (something or someone) for a long time, often unnecessarily 焦急地思考, 苦思, 沉思

- a) The problem won't improve for being brooded about. 这个问题不会因为苦思冥想就能好转。
- b) Tom has been brooding about whether he' 11 possibly find work again this winter. 汤姆一直在焦急地思考着这个冬天他能否再找到工作。care about: to like (someone or something); be fond
  - of (someone) 对……感兴趣;关心;注意
    - a) A selfish person does not care about other people's difficulties. 自私的人是不关心别人的困难的。
    - b) I don't care about what you think, I'm sure he is right. 我不管你是 怎么想的,我确信他是正确的。
- call about to arrive at (someone's) home, office etc., in order to discuss or investigate (something) 为了讨论,调查或商量(某事)而访问某人
  - a) There is a man at the door who says he is calling about your insurance. 门口有一个人, 他说要和你商量一下保险费用一事。
  - b) Excuse me, Mrs. Ramsay, I have been asked by my Head office to call about your outstanding debt on the cooker. 打扰了, 拉姆齐太太,是

总公司派我来和你商量有关你还未还清的炊具款项一 事的。

- cast about/around:to search anxiously about(one)for (something) 寻找;想办法
  - a) The prisoner cast about him for a way of escape. 囚犯寻找逃跑的路线。
  - b) The scientists have been casting about them for some new approach in connection with the experiment. 科学家们一直在寻找进行这种试验的新途径。
- caution about: to warn(someone) officially about (something) or against (doing something) 警告
  - a) My teacher has cautioned me about my spelling. 老师已警告我应注意拼写。
  - b) The police man cautioned the motorist about his speed. 警察已警告过该汽车司机应注意行车 速度。
- circle about/around/round, to move in circles round (a place) 盘旋,环行
  - a) The helicopter circled about the flooded area looking for a proper landing field. 直升飞机在洪水地区上空盘旋,想找一处合适的地方降落。
  - b) The army circled about the city before attacking. 军队在进攻前先把那座城围困起来。
- close about/round.to surround(something or someone)
  gradually 包围; 围住

- a) The gurrillas moved quietly and quickly closed about the enemy. 游击队悄悄地行动, 很快就包围了敌人。
- b) As darkness closed about them, they decided to return home. 夜幕降临时,他们决定回家。concern about/over, to give one's attention to or worry(oneself)about(something or someone) 关心: 挂念
  - a) Don't concern youself about this matter。 你不必为此事操心。
- b) Why are you so concerned about the boy's safety? 你为什么这么关心 这个男孩的安全呢? confuse about. to give one's attention to or worry (oneself)about(something or someone) 使…… 混乱
  - a) His long lecture confused me about the topic. 他沉长的演讲使我把讲题都弄混了。
  - b) Many people are confused about the new way of measureing temperature. 测量温度的新方法把许多人都弄糊涂了。
- consult about. to ask the advice of (someone) about (something or someone) 与……商量
  - a) You should consult your doctor about your cough. 你应该去看医生,检查一下咳嗽的原因。
  - b) Parents can consult the teachers about their children. 家长可与教师商量孩子们的事情。

#### debate about.

- 1. to speak or argue at length 争论……事情
- a) The family is still debating about where to go for their holiday. 全家人还在争论去什么 地方度假的问题。
- b) The teachers have decided to debate about the housing question. 教师们已决定好好 讨论 一下 有关住房问题。
- 2. to think; have doubts about; try to decide about(something)盘算; 考虑; 思考
- a) I am still debating about whether to let you go to camp. 我一直在考虑是否让你去野营。
- b) I debated with my conscience about going before I decided. 我认真考虑一下去的问题之后再作出决定。
- deliberate about/on/over/upon: to consider (something) at length and with care 考虑, 检讨
  - a) They deliberated about the matter for two hours. 他们用了2个小时的时间考虑这件事情。
  - b) The committee have been deliberating all afternoon about the question of the new appointments. 委员会一下午都在考虑新的任选问题。
- disagree about/on/over: to have a different opinion about(something or someone) 不同意
  - a) I must disagree about the singer's performance.

我不欣赏这位歌唱家的表演。

b) Mr.and Mrs.Barett disagreed about what to name the baby. 巴雷特先生和夫人对给 婴儿取什么名字意见不一致。

#### dream about

- 1. to have a dream about (something or someone) 梦见; 梦到
- a) I dreamed about my parents last night. 我昨晚梦见我的父母了。
- b) He often dreamed about his comrades-in-arms who had died on the Long March. 他常常梦见他那些牺牲在长征路上的战友。
- 2. to have hopes for (something or doing something)向往; 渴望
- a) I have long dreamed about paying a visit to the Great Wall of China. 我一直渴望能游览长城。
- b) Many people dream about living on a beautiful island in the sea. 许多人向往能生活在一个美丽的海岛上。
- enquire (inquire) about. to try to get information about (something or someone) 查问, 询问; 了解
  - a) She enquired about her old friends when she met someone from her home town. 他碰上了家乡人,就打听她的老朋友们的情况。
  - b) The director is in the office, enquiring about

those papers that you promised to have ready for him. 主任在办公室里,在询问 你 答 应给他准备的那些论文呢。

- fall about/around, fall about/around one's ears, to fail suddenly 全完了

  - b) All our careful plans fell about our ears when the government changed the tax laws.政府改变了税收法,我们精心制定的全部计划都完了。
- feel about: to use one's hands to find something by touch near (one) 暗中摸索
  - a) When I got to cinema, the film had already begun, so I had to feel about seats in the dark. 我到达电影院时,影片已开映了,我只好摸黑去找座位。
  - b) My mother was feeling about her for the light switch when I entered the dark room. 我走进黑屋子时,妈妈正在摸着寻找电灯开关。
- fight about: to quarrel or fight with someone about (something) 因……而打起来
  - a) What are those children fighting about now? 那些孩子为了什么事情在打仗?
  - b) The little boys were fighting about a toy. 这几个小男孩为争一个玩具在打仗。

- forget about to fail to remember(someone, or something or doing something) 忘记
  - a) Did you forget about going to the bank? 你忘记去银行了吗?
  - b) The maid forgot about sweeping the room. 女仆忘记打扫房间了。
- fret about/over: to worry; become concerned, impatient, or anxious; suffer because of (someone. something or doing something) 为……而焦急
  - a) For these days the boy fretted about his lost dog. 这个男孩这些天一直在为丢失了狗而焦急不安。
  - b) It is no use fretting about missing the train, and we can always catch the next one. 为错过了火车而焦急是没有用的。我们总能赶上下一班火车。

## fuss about/over.

- to show care and worry, treat (someone or something) with anxious attention 过份关心(某人或某事)
- a) The teacher always fusses about the slower children. 老师总是过份关心那些比较笨的孩子。
- b) She is always fussing about something or other. 她总是为一些事情找无谓的烦恼。
- 2. to behave or move about in a nervous, excited

way 紧张不安地走来走去,举止不安

- a) The director has been fussing about the matter since morning; scarcely able to hide her impatience. 主任从早到现在一直对此事感到局 促不安,几乎不能掩饰住其不耐烦。
- b) What are you fussing about all day? 你整 天都在瞎忙些什么?

## go about:

- 1. to be able to move or travel around(a place) 走动; 到各处去旅行
- a) It is dangerous to go about the construction site without a safety helment. 不带安全帽在工地上走来走去是危险的。
- b) The quickest way to go about the city is by underground train. 逛这座城市 最快 的办法是 乘地铁。
- 2. to start(something or doing something) 着手外理;从事
- a) He knows how to go about repairing the TV set. 他知道如何着手修理这台电视机。
- b) It is no easy thing to learn a foreign language well. We must go about it earnestly. 学好一门外语不是件容易事情。我们必须认真对待。
- gossip about/of: to talk about (someone or something), often spreading stories which may not be true 漫谈,闲谈天,传播流言蜚语
