前 言

随着经济全球化的发展,社会对大学生的英语应用能力提出了更高的要求。教育部颁布的《大学英语课程教学要求》阐明:“大学英语的教学目标是培养学生的英语综合应用能力,特别是听说能力,使他们在今后工作和社会交往中能用英语有效地进行口头和书面的信息交流,同时增强其自主学习能力,提高综合文化素养,以适应我国社会发展和国际交流的需要。”基于这些要求并着眼于大学英语教学改革的新趋势,我们特组织了相关教师精心设计编写了本书。

在本教程中,我们通过大量真实而实用的语言输入,给学生提供良好的听力练习和模仿机会,为学生用英语表达自己的思想打好坚实的基础,使学生在提高听说能力的同时得到精神上的享受。

本教程选材广泛,涉及日常生活、社会习俗、体育、教育、文化、艺术等方面;形式多样,包括电影片断、新闻、演讲、歌曲、幽默故事、短文等。教程每单元的主体部分选用真实的语言片段,为学生提供语言学习的仿真环境,有利于学生了解英语国家的文化思想、生活习俗、社会道德等各方面的知识,提高英语学习的兴趣。教程每单元的练习部分还设有一定数量的与四、六级考试水平相当的听力模拟练习题,以帮助学生进行针对性的听力训练。

本书共 16 单元,每单元包括以下三部分:

1. 主体部分。全部选用原版有声资料,旨在为学生提供流畅自然的“活英语”。学生既可以练习听力,也可以跟读模仿,练习口语。
2. 休闲时刻。主要包括歌曲、诗歌、幽默故事等,供学生欣赏放松。
3. 练习部分。对听力技能进行综合训练,培养学生的听力能力。

本书可用于课堂教学,也可用于学生课外自学,使用时根据具体情况灵活掌握。书后附有录音原文及参考答案,全套教程配有 MP3 光盘。

囿于编者水平,书中不足之处敬请广大读者批评指正。
