这套《VOA 慢速新闻英语听力突破》系列从 VOA 慢速英语广播节目中精选出涵盖时事政治、热点新闻、财经商务、科技文化、人物特写、专题报道、学习园地等各方面的内容,使英语爱好者在提高听力的同时,能掌握一些政治、人文、商业、科技等方面的最常用词汇,同时增长见识,拓宽视野,为突破英语学习关打下深厚坚实的基础。

在编排上,本书突出听力重点词、实用句型和补充词汇。在正文后对该文中的重点句型给出具体分析,并对听力重点词及相关背景专业词汇给予注解。


