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出版说明

社会生活的信息化和经济全球化,使英语的重要性与日俱增。英语已成为人类生活中各个领域使用最广泛的语言之一。因此我们特组织有关专家经过艰苦的努力,编撰了这部《中小学生英汉双解词典》。

本词典体例新颖,风格独特,双解释义简明清晰;例句贴切,浅显易懂;短语、固定搭配覆盖广泛。对于一些难理解及常用词则详细讲解了其用法。

本词典的内容含量大,且最大限度地收录了紧跟时代 发展的新词,力求在有限的篇幅内提供尽可能多的信息 量,特别提供了一词多解、不同意义在句型中的运用与表 达,便于读者更好的掌握与运用。

本词典突出实用性、综合性、科学性,不仅适合中小学生使用,而且适合各类成人教育的教师和学生使用。

限于编者水平所限,疏漏之处在所难免,恳请广大读者及专家不吝赐教,以便再版时予以更正和提高。

一、词条

本词典对所收词条按如下顺序标注解释:

- 1. 全部词条均按英语字母顺序排列,用黑正体印刷。
- 2. 用国际音标注明发音。词缀、构词成分及缩写词语等一般不注明发音。
- 3. 本词典采用通用的词类缩略形式共分十一类:名词 (n.)、动词 (v.)、代词 (pron.)、形容词 (adj.)、副词 (adv.)、介词 (prep.)、数词 (num.)、连词 (conj.)、感叹词 (int.)、冠词 (art.)、助动词 (v. aux.)。
- 4. 一个词有不同拼法时,排在同一个词条内,用逗号分开。
- 5. 拼法相同,但词源、词义不同的词单立词条,在词的右上角标以数码1、2等。
 - 二、释义 一个词如果有多个释义义项用序码①②③···标识。 义项下先列出英文释义,再列出中文释义。

三、例证 1. 例句: 例句序码与释义序码相对应。例句中用one、one's 分别指本人(或自己)、本人的(或自己的);用sb. 、sb. 's 分别指某人(或别人)、某人的(或别人的);用sth. 代替某事。句中的...和~在译文部分也求对应,以使字义的关连明确。


