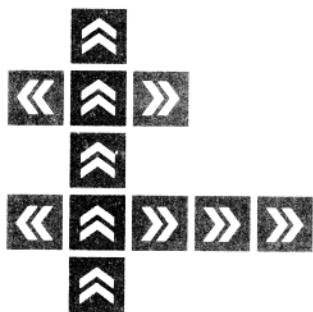

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编写说明

汇练、汇听、汇查丛书是由多年从事高中英语教学、有丰富指导高考经验的英语教师编写的。这套丛书适应高考命题的发展趋势，遵循高中英语教学的基本规律，科学运用语言学习理论，反映英语高考的最新动向，极具针对性和实战演练性，是不可多得的英语辅助教材。

首先，本丛书以遵循语言学习规律为第一原则，以教育部最新制订的《英语课程标准》为依据，较好地体现了大纲规定的功能意念和语言技能。教材紧扣现行新版高中英语教材内容，兼顾其它版本教材的知识点，题型与难易程度完全与近几年的高考试题衔接，内容最新、针对性最强、实战性最突出。

其次，语言规范地道，题材广泛。内容由浅入深、循序渐进，融知识性、趣味性、思想性、人文性于一体。材料多选自90年代以来的最新文字、广播、报刊、杂志、因特网，较好地反映了现代科技发展成果和新世纪社会文化及生活背景。

最后，练习形式不拘一格但重点突出。形式既有词语辨析、填空、正误判断、简答、句子排序、图表填写等题型，又有高考试题中常见的单项选择，能够从不同的角度训练学生的语言技能。另外，丛书在第一时间充分研究并吸收了历年高考和各省市高考命题的趋势，贯彻了我们始终坚持的从高一学年就遵循高考导向的训练原则，保证了丛书在内容和题型设计上与英语高考试题直接接轨，新颖、典型并具有代表性。

《**汇练 45 分钟英语基础巩固与能力提高——必修 1**》把现行教材的每一模块进行重组、整合。按照 45 分钟一堂课所学的内容进行练习。题型多样，形式新颖。有单词填空、词语辨析、短语填空、对话填空、单项填空。完型填空既有不给选项的短文填空又有高考类型的选项填空。阅读有任务型阅读和选择题两种。写作部分围绕模块话题分提纲提示、谴词造句、句型提示等内容进行背景知识补充。为进一步的写作进行必要的铺垫和知识储备。并且给出几个范文供学生参考，消除学生对写作的为难情绪，使他们从高一一开始就打下好基础，养成好习惯。此外，为了提高学生的人文素养，使学生对西方文化有更加深入的了解，以达到开拓学生视野、增长见识的目的，我们在每个模块的“相关词汇补充”和“文化视野扩充”栏目里增加了模块话题的背景知识介绍，语言简练、饶有趣味。

1 American teachers and students alike enjoy their summer vacation, but don't let the humor fool you.

2 Schools do more than just fill students' heads with knowledge. They pass on culture, traditions and values.

3 In fact, the casual class atmosphere often amazes international students. American teachers encourage students to think for themselves. Instead of grading students only on test scores, teachers evaluate (评价) papers, group projects and class participation as well. Students often have to think creatively to solve problems—not just memorize facts. Students also learn how to do research by using resource materials to find their own answers.

1. In Denmark, parents are allowed to set up a new school if they are dissatisfied with the school in the area

where they are living. Although these schools have to follow the national courses, they are allowed a lot of choice in deciding what to teach. Some of these new schools are called “small schools” because usually the number of pupils in them is only sixty, but a school has to have at least twenty-seven pupils.

Cooleenbridge School in Ireland, is a small school similar to the ones in Denmark, it was set up by parents who came from Holland, Germany, Czechoslovakia, England and other parts of Ireland. They came because they wanted to live in the countryside and to grow their own food. In June 1986, they decided to start a school. They managed to get an old, disused primary-school building and started with twenty-four children aged from four to twelve.

The teachers say, “The important thing in school is doing, not sitting.” And so the courses includes yoga, cooking, knitting, kite-making, music, fishing, drama (戏剧) and environmental (环境的) river studies, as well as reading, writing, maths and science.

2. The USA high school system is unlike that of many other countries. There is little national standardization in the typical USA high school. Individual states have great control over what coursework is taught in the USA high schools within their borders, as well as in the requirements that students must meet in order to graduate with a US high school diploma. Therefore, what courses and subjects are offered at US high schools will vary depending on where the high school is located.

The coursework will also vary depending on whether the USA high school is public or private. US public high schools are operated by the government and are financed by public funds. These high schools are free to all students, even foreigners. The quality of education can vary greatly between different public USA high schools, primarily because of differences in the amount of funding that different high schools receive. Private US high schools are operated by private individuals and are financed by private funds. These private high schools are not controlled by any government agency, but their students must still meet the minimum graduation requirements set by the state. All US private high school students must pay tuition, regardless of their nationality. Private USA high schools are popular because they offer options that are not available at public high schools. These may include advanced math and science courses, a broader selection of foreign languages, and better art, music and athletic programs.

Penrose High School

We are involved in the various cultural festivals and have our own cultural celebrations. Students are encouraged to gain an awareness of other countries and their cultures which in turn fosters a strong team spirit within the school. Penrose High School is a school where children feel a sense of belonging.

One of the main advantages at Penrose High School is that it has very large sports fields, gymnasium and park-like student lunch areas amid mature trees. We encourage students to participate in activities outside classroom. These activities develop physical, mental and social skills. They build students' self-esteem and confidence. This, in turn, is often reflected in greater achievement in the classroom.

The New York Institute for Special Education

The New York Institute for Special Education (NYISE) is a private educational facility which provides quality programs for children who are blind, emotionally and learning disabled and preschoolers who are developmentally delayed.

The school was founded in 1831 as one of the first schools in the United States to provide an educational program for children who were blind. Today, our school continues its rich tradition of educating children who are blind. In the 1980's educators recognized the need to provide programs designed specifically for students with learning and emotional disabilities and established the program for those children who could not be served in a traditional school setting. In 1987, a program for developmentally delayed preschoolers was established.

Nearly 300 students from ages 3 to 21 now attend NYISE. The school offers the options of a day program or a five day residential program. All students return home on weekends and holidays. An Individualized Education Program is developed for each student. In addition, a full array of services is provided, which include counseling, career guidance, occupational therapy, physical therapy and speech-language therapy, individual and team sports and adaptive recreational activities.

The High School Dublin

The High School Dublin is a coeducational secondary school for about 780 pupils. It was founded by the Erasmus Smith trust in 1870 as a day school for boys. Originally located in Harcourt Street, it moved in 1971 to its present 23-acre setting in Rathgar, bringing with it over 100 years of distinguished educational tradition. In 1974 The High School merged with The Diocesan School for Girls and became coeducational. It provides education mainly for pupils from Church of Ireland families, while having places available for those of other faiths. The experience gained through the working out of this policy and through respecting the needs of minority groups and individuals enriches the whole life of the school.

The school is managed by a committee of the Board on which parents and staff are represented. It is directed by the Principal, supported by a staff of approximately 60 qualified, dedicated and committed teachers with a wide range of skills and interests. The High School gives its pupils the opportunity to explore the humanities, sciences, arts, business studies and technical subjects. In addition it provides religious, moral and physical education in order to meet its founding objectives of preparing pupils for the demands of business and professional life, and of attaining high academic standards in the broad range of disciplines required for third level education.
