前 言

《英语听力级级跳》是根据江苏省普通高等教育面向 21 世纪教学内容和课程体系改革计划中的立项"高等院校大学英语辅导听力内容和手段的研究与改革(编号为 0004 - 3)"编写的一套系列听力辅助教材。

英语是一门实践性很强的课程,组织学生在有指导的情况下提高听力能力是当务之急,是将继续提高语言能力必不可少的条件。目前,英语听力教材相对比较单一,各学校听力课时不足,课外缺乏对学生听力的指导及相配套的听力材料;很多学校虽设有外语教学电台,但因缺乏适用的录音材料而不能充分发挥其作用。本着探索富有创意的听力教学新理论、新方法、使听力教学更好地为贯彻教学大纲服务、实施英语素质教育的原则,为开辟好第二课堂,特编写同步辅导和泛听的、适用面极广的《英语听力级级跳》。

本教材共分四册,全书配有有声资料。本教材编写时注意到 交际性、趣味性、知识性,由浅人深,并尽量兼顾到目前全国英语等 级考试中的听力题型。

本教材编写过程中受到省教委的关注。南京大学出版社的编辑同志及南京大学、东南大学、南京航空航天大学、南京铁道医学院等院校大外部或外语系的同志给我们提供了宝贵的意见,并给予很大支持。

编写说明

《英语听力级级跳》为提高使用者的英语听力水平而专门设计,一套四册。基本相当于大学英语考试(CET)1-6级;对应国家考试中心最新推出的全国公共英语等级考试(PETS)的1-4级,并覆盖部分5级试题,循序渐进,逐级提高。本教材编写时以素质教育为基础,注意到交际性、趣味性、知识性,以英语国家的各类文化知识为背景,贯穿语言知识的常用点和难点,由浅人深,梯度明显,并尽量兼顾到目前全国各级英语考试中经常出现的听力题型,具有很强的实用性。

本丛书配有专门的录音带,每本四盒,由资深外籍专家专门录音,音质纯正,发音清晰;数码录音设备和专业的制作水平保证了录音带质量的清晰动听。尤其是每本书根据各级听力考试要求而严格设计的语速和间隔,有助于使用者对自身听力水平的把握与提高。

本丛书从打基础开始,为逐级提高英语水平而设计,适用面极 广。读者既可全套使用,从头起步,逐级提高,也可根据自己的现 有水平从中选择,在某一级上重点突破。

目前大多数高校设有外语教学电台,本书特别适合做播音材料。试用阶段曾在多所高校校园广播站播出,学生、教师反映极好。
