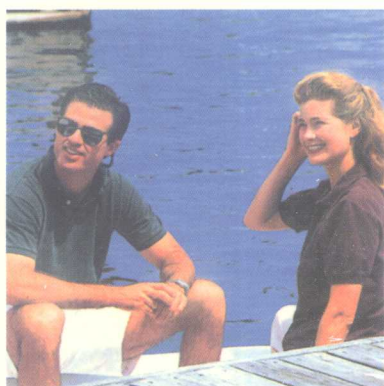

 CAROL: What about Thursdays?
 LINDA: On Thursday we do fashion. I want
 65 some beautiful dresses. Maybe some
 hats.
 SUSAN: What else?
 LINDA: I like stories about people. I like
 stories with action. I like good
 70 pictures.
 JAKE: Are we in the stories?
 LINDA: Sometimes. We need good stories, and
 we need them now!

NOTES 注释

- Line 2** 收视率下降对于一个电视台来说确实是一个 **big problem** (大问题)。**problem** 是“问题”的意思,用 **big** (大的) 来修饰它,指问题的严重性。
- 3 rating** 是“比率”的意思,此处指“收视率”。
- 6** 有时候你看到你的朋友不舒服时,你会非常关切地问一句“你怎么啦?”这时候就用到了“**What's the problem?**”当然,我们也可以用其他的句子来表达这个意思,最常用的就是“**What's wrong with you?**”比如: **You look terrible, what's the problem?** 你看起来不舒服,怎么啦?
- 7 report** 是动词,做“报道”讲,如果就什么事情进行报道,后面要加介词 **on** 或 **about**,如: **Jake Seltzer is reporting on baseball.** 杰克·萨尔茨在进行棒球报道。**report** 还可以做名词,如下面即将出现的 **weekend report** (周末报道),我们每天都要看的 **news report** (新闻报道) 等。
- 8 always** 是“一直、总是”的意思,与后面出现的 **usually** (通常), **often** (常常), **sometimes** (有时) 等,用于一般现在时,表示经常的动作或经常发生的现象。如: **He always gets up at six.** 他总是六点钟起床。
- 11** 在这儿 **look** 是一个系动词,是“看起来”的意思。后面可以跟形容词。如: **You look fine today.** 你今天看起来气色很好。后面出现的 **look great, look nice, look good** 等用法都是相同的。**sometimes** 表示“有时”,用于一般现在时。如: **Sometimes I get up at six o'clock.** 我有时六点起床。
- 17** 人们都喜欢 **music** (音乐),年轻人尤其喜欢 **pop music** (流行音乐)。有些人喜欢听音乐,有些人喜欢看音乐电视,那就是我们常说的 **MTV (music television)**。下面我们谈到的 **rock music** (摇滚乐) 也是大家喜爱的一种音乐。
- 21** “猫王”在美国七十年代风靡一时,他的音乐就是 **rock music** (摇滚乐)。
- 24** 很多女孩子对新潮的服装情有独钟,于是媒体对 **fashion shows** (时装表演) 也备加青睐。**fashion** 是“时髦,时尚”的意思,常用词组有 **in fashion** (流行) 和 **out of fashion** (过时)。
- 26** 当形容词修饰名词时,放在名词的前面。如: **People like important news.** 人们喜欢重要的消息。当形容词修饰 **something, anything, nothing** 等不定代词时,要放在不定代词的后面。如: **We need something important.** 我们需要一些重要的东西。
- 32 think** 是“想,认为”的意思。如: **I think this is right.** 我认为这是正确的。短语 **think about** 则是“考虑”的意思。遇到问题时,要好好想一想。如: **Think about it, and you should give me the**

answer this afternoon. 好好考虑考虑, 今天下午给我答复。

- 36 当你对别人的观点表示同意时, 最简单的方法就是说一个词 “right”。实际上这是一个省略句, 完整的句子应该是: “You are right.” (你的看法是正确的。) right 是 “正确的” 的意思。比如: My answer is the only right one. 我的回答是唯一正确的。
- 39 like 后面跟动词不定式, 也就是 like to do something, 表示 “喜欢干……”。比如: I like to sleep on Sunday. 我喜欢在星期天睡大觉。like 后面也可以直接跟名词。比如: I like bananas. 我喜欢香蕉。
- 45 我们在前面已经学过了 “What about . . . ?” (……怎么样?) 现在我们又学到了 “How about . . .”, 如: What about (How about) Tuesday? 星期二怎么样啊?
- 45 night 和 evening 二者是有区别的: night 指太阳落山之后到第二天黎明之前的一段时间; 而 evening 则是指傍晚时分。“晚上好!” 应该用 “Good evening!” 而当我们准备休息, 互道 “晚安” 时, 就要说 “Good night!”
- 47 “Do you like to dance?” (你喜欢跳舞吗?) 我们平常跳的舞蹈为交谊舞 (social dance), 大型歌剧团表演芭蕾舞 (ballet), 当然还有一些民间舞蹈 (folk dance)。
- 67 else 作副词, 意为 “另外, 其他, 别的”。“What else do you want to know?” (你还想知道些什么?)

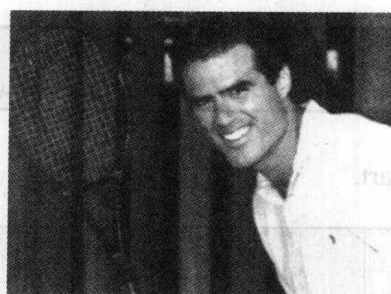
