前言

《新认知大学实用英语综合教程》是根据教育部高教司颁布的《高职高专教育英语课程教学基本要求》而编写。本教程注重英语语言基础和基本技能训练,特别强调培养学生用英语进行交际的实际运用能力,以满足 21 世纪社会对高职高专人才的要求。

本教程将听、说、读、写、译融为一体,使之形成一个有机的整体,以培养学生运用英语的综合能力。

本教程本着内容的实用性、新颖性和广泛性进行选材,语言力求规范和真实。在 编排上注重从高职高专学生的实际水平和需求出发,按程度和题材分册、分单元循序 渐进。

《综合教程》每册有 8 个单元,每单元由听说训练、阅读训练、语法训练、实用写作训练组成。"听说训练"包括对各种日常交际和听力理解技能的训练。"阅读训练"包括两篇同一题材的文章,精读文章 Text A 配有主题讨论、阅读理解、词汇、结构、翻译等练习。泛读文章 Text B 配有阅读理解和课外翻译练习。"语法训练"系统复习已学语法知识,包括语法理论知识的简介和相关语法练习题的操练。"实用写作训练"介绍学生今后工作和生活中所需的常用应用文并配有相应的写作训练。

《练习册》包括两部分。第一部分是根据《综合教程》中各单元的精读和泛读文章 内容设计的阅读理解和词汇结构练习,旨在消化、巩固和考查课堂教学内容。第二部 分是根据"高等学校英语应用能力考试"(PRETCO)的要求而编写的样题。

《教学用书》包括两部分。第一部分为教师提供与《综合教程》内容相关的教学计划、背景知识、语言要点和难句释例和课文译文。第二部分包括《综合教程》和《练习册》的练习答案和听力文字材料。

本教程由徐品忠老师担任总主编,负责教材编写的全面工作。第2册由刘欣老师和魏丽琼老师担任主编,罗胜杰老师审阅了全书,谨此致谢。书中若有疏漏,欢迎读者不吝赐教。

使用说明

本书共有八个单元,每单元由内容简介、听说训练、阅读训练、语法复习、应用文写作组成。

内容简介简单介绍每个单元的内容,明确学生应该掌握的语言知识和技能。 听说训练由两大部分组成。

Communicative Skills 包括对各种交际技能的训练,主要内容有三个对话,要求学生边听边做填空练习。Creative Dialogues 要求学生根据所给情景,模仿所听材料和常用表达法组织对话,旨在培养学生的口头表达能力。

Listening Comprehension 包括三项听力理解训练。内容有问答、对话和短文, 练习形式有选择题、填充题和简短回答。

听力技巧讲解一些基本的听力学习方法和技能,以提高学生的听力理解能力。

阅读训练包括两篇同一题材的文章,Text A 为精读,Text B 为泛读。Text A 配有单词、词组和专有名词表、难句解释和多项练习。生词释义采用英汉相结合,英语解释力求简洁明了。

Text A 的练习有两大板块:课文理解和语言要点。课文理解有四项练习 Prereading Questions, Reading Aloud, Answering Questions, Giving Opinions。语言 要点有五项练习:Words, Phrases, Structure, Word Formation 和 Translation.

Pre-reading Questions 围绕课文主题进行讨论,以提高学生的阅读兴趣,为学习课文做准备。

Reading Aloud 摘选课文中的部分段落或相关内容的材料供学生朗读和背诵。

Answering Questions 通过问答形式加深学生对课文的理解。

Giving Opinions 引导学生在理解课文的基础上就相关问题进行更深入的讨论,引导学生各抒已见,旨在活跃课堂气氛和启迪思想。

Words & Phrases 操练课文中出现的常用词和词组,帮助学生掌握它们的用法。 Structure 选取课文中出现的英语常用结构进行操练,帮助学生掌握英语中的一 些习惯表达法。

Word Formation 帮助学生熟悉英语中最常用的构词法,以拓展学生的词汇量。

Translation 分汉译英和英译汉两种练习。汉译英复习课文中的常用词和词组, 英译汉选取课文中的句子和段落,帮助学生巩固课文内容。

Text B配有单词、词组、阅读理解练习和词汇练习。

语法系统复习中学已学语法知识,以易混淆的语法现象为重点,进行综合练习。 教师可根据学生的具体情况在课堂上详细讲解此部分或让学生自测。

写作部分主要介绍的是商务信函,并配有相应的写作训练,旨在帮助学生熟练掌握常见的商务应用文格式和常用的表达法,提高学生的写作能力。



Introduction

This is the first unit of Book Two. In the Listening & Speaking section, you will learn how to talk about activities of taking a break. Text A provides you with a general picture of John Fitzgerald Kennedy, whose family are always in the limelight. Text B is a story about Elvis Presley — a super star in Hollywood.

Upon completion of this unit, students are required to:

- 1) get familiar and create dialogues with the frequently used expressions of taking a break;
- 2) understand the main ideas of the text A and text B, grasp the words, expressions, used in the texts, and discuss the texts among peers;
 - 3) get familiar with the basic sentence patterns;
 - 4) know how to establish trade relations.
