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#### 内容简介

本书是在作者积聚多年外语教学经验,尤其是各种高级英语听力(诸如硕士生听力、TOEFL 听力、WSK 听力、BFT 听力等)的教学经验基础上,经过精心编排,从选材到练习上都体现了新、高、实用的特色。经过在数届博士生的听力教学及 WSK 听力教学中的使用,证实它是一本针对性强、实用率高、训练强度较大的高级英语听力教材,更因其融听力理解基础与听力测试训练于一体,其实用性更强。所以本书可作为参加全国大学英语六级统考教学用书,也可作为具有中级英语水平的硕士生、博士生及高级技术人员等提高教学用书,对于准备参加 TEM 考试的英语专业学生及准备参加各类出国考试如 WSK,BFT 和TOEFL 的学生和学者,该书是很好的考前强化听力教材。

# 前言

事 音

1994年6月初稿

国家教育委员会于 1985 年颁布了理工科和文理科高等院校《大学英语教学大纲》,又在 1992 年颁布了《非专业研究生英语教学大纲》。两个大纲都明确规定了听力要求。无论是通过大学英语四、六级全国统考,还是更有效地参与改革开放的工作实践,听力都是重要的环节。迅速提高听的能力已成为广大英语爱好者的迫切愿望。

1994年夏国家教委分别在大学英语、公外研究生英语教学研讨会上提出全国外语教学要在 2000年上个新台阶,要提倡"素质教育",其教学重点应放在培养学生运用外语进行交际的能力上,并准备从 1995年秋在全国四、六级统考中增加近年来国际英语教学中流行的练习形式听写,以测试学生综合运用英语的能力。

高标准的英语水平要求呼唤着高起点的英语听力教材的诞生。

本书是根据上述两个教学大纲精神,并结合听力能力培养的新趋势而编写的,在练习编排时特别加强了"听写"、"边听边记"及听后书写简短总结(150词左右)等练习,将听和写有机的联系起来。

"训练强度大"、"内容新颖"是本书的另外两大特点。该书绝大部分语料选自近年来出版的原文报刊杂志和听力教材,语言地道,内容丰富、新颖,集趣味性、知识性、实用性于一体,涉及科技、风俗习惯、人物传记、日常知识、文化教育、经济、法津等方面知识,以培养学生正确的语感,有关的词汇量丰富,训练强度在某些方面超过 WSK、TOEFL 等高级听力教材。因此该书可作为各种高级英语听力应试的首选教材。

本书包括二十个单元和五套模拟测试题。其目的是使学生接受大量单句,简短问答,短篇讲话、叙述、解说等的听力训练,通过多项选择,听写填空和做听力笔记,写小结等形式多样的练习,以及综合测试,最终达到一遍听懂语速为每分钟 140 词至 200 词的一般性题材和科普题材的篇章材料,理解语篇各部分之间的关系和话语的交际价值或功能,领会语篇中的主要论点,继而为听懂本专业的学术报告、获取专业所需信息奠定基础。

综上所述,本书可作为参加大学英语六级统考教学用书,可作为硕士生、博士生及高级技术人员等提高用书,也可供准备参加 TEM 考试的英语专业学生及准备参加各类出国考试,如WSK,BFT 和 TOEFL 等学生或学者进行考前强化训练之用,还可作为训练听懂标准广播英语(如 Radio China International, B. B. C., V. O. A. 广播英语)的先期强化材料。该书可供学生自听自测,亦可由教师指导进行课堂训练。

与本书配套的录音磁带(八盒)特聘浙江大学外藉专家及教师专门录制,发音准确、清晰、 纯真。为方便读者,本书后附有听力录音文本及答案,但万不可未听先阅或边听边阅,否则将失 去听力练习的作用。
