新题与老题

新托福考试(TOEFL internet-Based Test)2005年9月率先在北美地区登陆,2006年8月席卷中国,号称托福考试的一场划时代的变革。在此变革中,最引人注目的部分当然是由6道题组成的口语考试,尤其值得关注的是,2008年有多次考试的题目是以前考题的原题重现,例如:

2008年1月5日大陆新托福考题与2006年12月16日大陆新托福考题完全一样; 2008年1月13日大陆新托福考题与2006年10月21日大陆新托福考题完全一样; 2008年1月19日大陆新托福考题与2006年11月5日大陆新托福考题完全一样; 2008年2月2日大陆新托福考题与2007年1月19日大陆新托福考题完全一样; 2008年2月16日大陆新托福考题与2006年12月3日大陆新托福考题完全一样; 2008年2月24日大陆新托福考题与2006年10月29日大陆新托福考题完全一样;

2008年口语考试多次重题,这就提示我们要对以前两年曾经考过的题目格外重视,尤其是口语第一题和第二题,许多所谓的新题其实就是以前老题的翻版甚至是原题重现。因此,了解历次考题的体裁、题材,熟练掌握历次考题的场景、词汇、题型、答题步骤和技巧就成为顺利取得高分的关键。

二、Task 1 真题及满分答案

以上统计研究表明,新托福考试出题是具有可预测性的,一些重点题目在考试中会再次甚至多次重复出现,这种现象在口语考试的 Task 1 和 Task 2 中尤其明显,甚至经常会以原题的形式出现。考生要对 2006—2008 年曾经考过的题目格外重视,许多所谓的新考题其实就是以前老题的翻版或者是原题重现。因此,了解历次考题,并对其中的一些重点题目有所准备,是快速取得高分的捷径,对于一些基础较差的考生就更是如此。

下面的 23 个题目大部分是历次考题的题目,已经标出曾经出题的日期,有的题目没有标明出题日期,但仍然是常考话题,也是备考的重点内容。这些题目在接下来的考试中还会以原题或翻版的形式再次出现,请考生认真准备,灵活运用,定能达到事半功倍的效果。

1. Describe an important subject and explain why it is so important to you.
