## 前 言

本书作者长期从事我国英语听说教学理论研究及英语听说课程教学实践,本书的编写充分反映了当前英语教学领域前沿的教学思想和模式,其宗旨在于通过听力教材向英语学习者提供自信、舒适、愉快的英语听说训练条件,从而使学习者取得英语听说能力尽快提高的最佳效果。

本书共二十课,每课由四部分组成。

第一部分是对话理解部分,着重培养学习者听懂各种情景中的英语对话,其新颖之处在于对话全部选自近年来欧美英语国家拍摄的电影(如《楚门的世界》、《网络情缘》等)。

第二部分是听写部分,着重培养学习者听英语的注意力,其独到之处在于听写内容全部是国际名人近年在各种场合所作的发言片断(如 MBA 超级球星迈克·乔丹的退役发言等)。

第三部分是短文理解部分,通过科学设计的练习,使学习者对所听短文的理解能够由粗到细,循序渐进,因此逐渐提高其对语篇的理解能力。同时,本部分的选材照顾到了各种学习者不同的兴趣爱好,既有最新的国际新闻报道(如有关导致英国巴林银行破产的里森出狱的消息等),也有名人轶事(如好莱坞影星施瓦辛格的恋爱故事等),又有反映最新科学研究动态的信息。

第四部分的目的是培养学习者说英语的能力。许多英语学习者练习英语口语的困难之一是缺乏合适的话题。因此,本部分设计了一些使学习者有话可谈的话题,学习者在听懂并复习每课前三部分的内容的基础上,学习并掌握涉及某个话题的词汇、语句,从而能够用英语进行畅谈。这些话题还能够激发学习者在“英语

角”等英语口语练习场所的灵感,并助其增强口语训练的毅力。
