



历方图读法

所谓"听觉阅读法"指的是用耳朵直接听文章的录音,而非用眼睛直接看。美国口语专家罗斯的一份研究报告表明,在语言交际活动中,听的方面占的比重最大(听、说、读、写所占的比重分别为 42%、32%、15%、11%)。听是一个人获得信息、摄取知识和发展智力的重要途径,也是一个人社交技能高低的重要标志。从广义上说,阅读也是一个"用耳听"的过程——眼睛识别到图像信息之后首先会传导到大脑,大脑将图像信息默读给耳朵听,转变成听觉信息,然后耳朵再将这些听觉信息传递给语言中枢,形成理解和判断。与其通过这样一个"绕弯子"的过程,我们还不如直接把阅读的文章拿来听。通过外籍专家充满情感、抑扬顿挫的朗读,我们就可以很容易地形成语感,并提高对句中意群的把握能力,突破长难句识别和理解上的瓶颈。

随着科技的快速发展,可以预见的是,不远的将来,我们将会迎来新一波的阅读文化的洗礼,从"文字阅读",到"图像阅读",现在轮到"听觉阅读"。我们的生活和学习,将渐变成一种流动的听觉体验。与文字及图像阅读相比,现在更多人通过聆听来接受经典文学或知识的洗礼,像名著、外文学习资料等,都可方便地通过声音去阅读。
