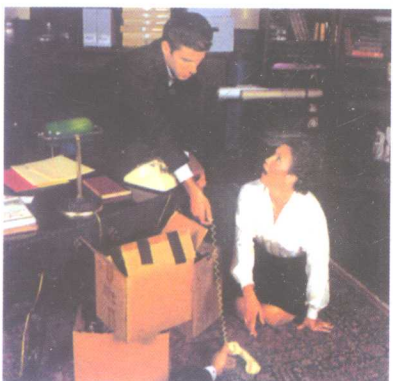
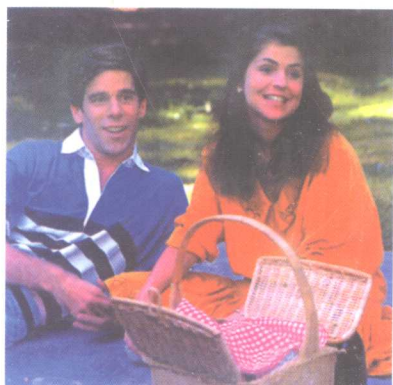

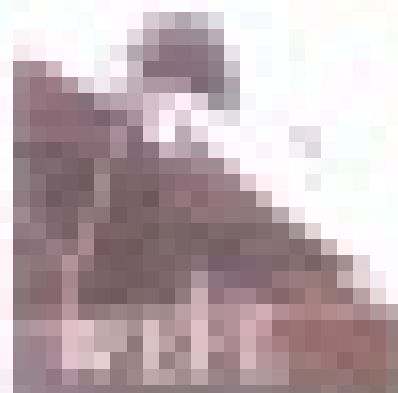

RITA: Well . . . the skirt isn't long enough . . . the sweater isn't bright enough . . . and the pants are too tight. Oh, of course the pants go back to the men's department.

55 CLERK: Well, let's get started. Now what about this skirt?

RITA: It's too short.

CLERK: What size is it?

RITA: Size seven.

60 CLERK: Just a moment.

CLERK: Here are some skirts. They're longer. Those pajamas are nice, aren't they?

65 RITA: Yes. I need to get some pajamas, but these are too expensive.

CLERK: They're going to be on sale next week.

NOTES 注释

Line 9 work 在这里做动词, 意思是“起作用, 有效”。例如:

The experiment has not worked very well. 实验并不很成功。

Your idea won't work in practice. 你的想法实际上行不通。

21 exchange 的意思是“更换, 调换”。当你买到了不满意的东西时, 就可以用 exchange 这个词换到你满意的东西, 你可以说: “I want to/I'd like to/I need to exchange . . . ” (我想换……) 如果要表达“把……换成……”的意思时, 就得用 exchange . . . for . . . 。例如:

She exchanged the blue dress for a yellow one. 她把那件蓝衣服换了一件黄色的。

Where can I exchange my RMB for dollars? 我在哪儿可以把人民币换成美元?

23 当我们要描述某个东西“足够……”时, 则要用副词 enough, 它修饰形容词时必须放在所修饰的形容词后, 否定式直接加 not, not . . . enough 即可表示“不够……”的意思。例如:

She has a good enough voice to be a professional singer. 她的嗓子够好的, 可以当一名职业歌手。

A: Are these shoes large enough? 这鞋尺寸够大吗?

B: They aren't large enough. 它们还不够大。

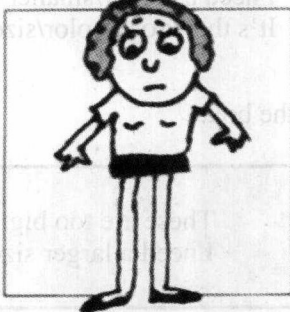

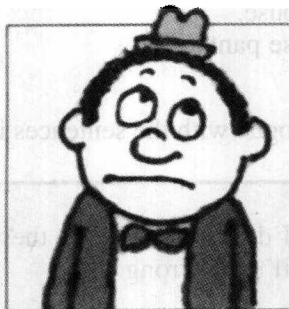
