- (二)取材廣博 本書所搜集之成語,凡 五千餘句,均係學校課本,文學名著及 報章雜誌中所常見者,備此一書,閱讀 時所有疑難,均可迎及而解。
- (三)解釋正確 本書解釋, 簡明正確。 凡一語而兼有數解者, 即于各解釋前 分別冠以 1, 2, 3, 等阿剌伯數字, 清 斯異常。
- (四) 例句實用 本書每一成語,均附有 例句,一語有數解者,即有數種例句, 各例句前,亦冠以數字,與解釋前之數 字,完全符合。學者對于成語之解釋,

若有不能了解處,一讀例句,必能**激底** 領悟。

(五)編排新穎 本書編排,極爲新穎,之 序先後,一依成語之第一字母,如普通 英文字典相同,極易翻查。 成語下爲 下解」,卽解釋,解釋下爲「例」卽例 句,層次井然。 例句中之成語,則用 斜體字排印,一目了然。
