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编者的话

为了帮助高中学生以及具有同等英语程度的读者较快地学好英语,我们编辑了这套《中级英语读物》丛书,原由江苏人民出版社出版,现改由江苏教育出版社分辑出版。丛书内容包括:《世界优秀故事选》、《英语幽默与语言游戏》、《英美名诗选》、《英语现代散文选》、《国外英语课文选》、《外国寓言童话选》、《外国神话与传说》、《英语科普小品选》以及《英语国家概况》等。选材不求系统全面,主要是向读者提供一些英语注释读物,作为学习英语的辅助材料。

《国外英语课文选》是从美、英等国新近出版的英语教科书中精选编辑而成的。全书共收集了四十课课文。这些课文主要选自渐进阅读丛书的《阅读范本》第二、三、四册 (Progressive Reading Series: A Reading Sampler, Books 2, 3 and 4)、《十五篇英语通俗课文》 (Fifteen Easy Pieces for EFL) 以及《听力理解实践课本》 (Listening Comprehension Practice)等。这些课文介绍了美英等国的社会背景、风土人情、生活习惯、史地知识和名人轶事。选文短小,题材多样,内容丰富,生动风趣,选文语言规范、朴素简洁、浅显易懂。本书适宜供中学师生、业余英语爱好者阅读、欣赏,以丰富知识,提高英语水平,也可供英语教师从中选择有关篇章作补充教材,或作听写和考试测验之用。此外,我们在每课课

文后附上了原有的各种练习,如词汇填空、语法练习、阅读 理解练习、课堂讨论题等。我们希望本书对英语教学能有所 帮助。

由于水平有限,本书注释中可能有欠妥或错讹之**处,希** 望读者批评指正。

1. The Sunday Newspaper

Many people go to church on Sunday, but others don't. 1 Many sleep late² on Sunday morning, but others don't. Some people work on Sunday, but most don't. However, almost everyone reads the Sunday paper. 3

Often the paper is waiting outside the door when the family gets up. The newspaper boy⁴ has delivered⁵ it.

The Sunday paper is usually very thick. It has many advertisements and many different sections. The adults in the family like the front page, the editorial page, and the world news section. Many men also read the sports pages and the financial pages. 12

Most men don't read the women's pages, but the mother of the family usually does. The women's pages have news about parties¹³ and marriages, and advice¹⁴ about food, health, and clothes.

Most Sunday papers have comics¹⁵, which children enjoy.¹⁶ Older people read the death notices¹⁷, which¹⁸ tell about people who have died during the week.

There is something for everyone in the Sunday paper.

2. Which States Have the Most People?

California has the largest population of any of the states. ¹ Nearly 20,000,000 people live in California. In 1960 California had the second largest population, and New York ² was first. Today, however, New York is second with a population of 18,000,000. Pennsylvania ³ is third with a population of 12,000,000. The fourth state, Texas, ⁴ has a population of 11,000,000.

The fifth, sixth, and seventh largest states in population⁵ are Illinois, ⁶ Ohio, ⁷ and Michigan. ⁸ New Jersey, ⁹ Florida, ¹⁰ and Massachusetts ¹¹ are the eighth, ninth, and tenth largest states.

Although Alaska is the largest state in size, ¹² it is the smallest in population. Alaska had only 303,000 people in 1970.

3. Ecology¹ on a College Campus²

The University of California³ has many campuses. One campus is in Santa Cruz,⁴ California. Some of the Santa Cruz students are learning about ecology by living on a farm.⁵

These students do not live in modern buildings. They live in tents on the 17-acre farm⁶ on which they raise⁷ fruits and vegetables without using machines.

Every morning, before they go to their university classes, 8 the students feed the chickens and milk the goats. 9 They receive no pay for their work, 10 and they do not receive college credit, either. 11 They are working on the farm because they want to learn about the land.

Stephen Kaffka, the 24-year-old manager of the farm, says: 12 "It's a conscious effort to find an ecological and satisfying means of being in the world." 13
