



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## 校订序言

自 1988 年起,我们着手出版供大学非外语专业本科生使用的英语分级标准考试系列录音教材。自第一部教材问世至今,有好几部的配套文字教材已重印多次。这表明,这套系列录音教材已得到许多院校师生的认可。为了更大面积地推广这套教材,使之更好地在大学英语教学中发挥作用,我们组织编者对各配套文字教材做了校订,并且重新排版,以新的面貌奉献给大家。

## 前 言

目前高等院校采用的《大学英语教学大纲》，反映了国家培养高级人才的要求和规格。国家教委在批转《大纲》的通知中规定：对结束四、六级学习的学生进行统一的标准考试。为了适应分级教学和标准考试的需要，我们选编了英语分级标准考试系列录音教材。它包括《大学英语听力测验》(1~3级、4级、5~6级)、《大学英语四级统考指南》、《大学英语四级考试模拟试题集》、《大学英语六级考试模拟试题集》、《大学英语四、六级语法指南》。

《大学英语听力测验》(5—6级)有4盒录音磁带，内容包含：

**5级听力测验** 共4套模拟试题。每套约30分钟，其中有10个单句，10组对话，3篇短文。题材为学生所熟悉，句子结构不太复杂，基本上没有生词，语速每分钟约140词。各题读两遍，间歇为13秒钟，以供多项选择答题。理解准确率以70%为合格。(5级占两盒磁带)

**6级听力测验** 共6套模拟试题。每套约20分钟，20题，包括10组对话(选材的原则是交际场合中的一般对话)和3篇短文(选材原则是题材熟悉的交谈、报告、叙述、解说等)。所用词语不超出教学大纲词汇表6级规定的范围，语速每分钟约140词。各题只读一遍，间歇为13秒钟，以供多项选择答题。理解准确率以70%为合格。(6级占两盒磁带)

本教材所提供的录音磁带的语音、语调规范，语速及停顿时间完全按《大纲》规定的指标。本套磁带特聘外籍专家录制，以利于提高学生听力的适应能力。

在编选本教材的过程中曾得到我校校长蒋德明教授的大力支持，外语系系主任郝克琦教授为全书作了审校，在此我们表示衷心的感谢。
