# 前言

完型填空是外语学习中的一种综合练习或测试形式。这种题型的特点是给出一篇短文,将短文中的若干词语删去,留出空白,短文后有供每个空白选择的答案,要求学生先通读短文掌握大意之后,再从每个供选择的四项答案中选择一个可供填入相应空白处的最佳答案。也有的是将短文中的若干词语删去,留出空白,让学生根据上下文的意思直接填入适当的词。完型填空是一种难度较大的题型,它不仅考查学生对语法知识和词汇掌握的情况,而且考查学生阅读和理解英语文章的能力。因此,要解好这种题必须做大量的练习,通过实践来提高学生综合运用语言、理解语篇并进行填空的能力。在填空时一般遵循这样几项原则:首先是通读全文、掌握其大意,然后边读边做。在填空时要联系上下文,进行通盘考虑。既要考虑所填词的语法要求,又要考虑词的意义是否恰当。填完后再通读一遍,看所填词的意思是否通顺合理。

本书是我们在对学生进行多年英语教学训练的基础上,精选精编而成的,总共200篇。书中篇章内容新颖,代表性强,可读性强。它包括小故事、名人轶事、一般性史地常识、日常生活和科普知识等方面的内容。书中的完型填空篇章难度适中,它遵循由易到难,循序渐进的原则排列,为提高高中学生综合运用语言并进行填空的能力及应考能力做了精心的安排。

本书中的单词量是以中学英语教学大纲所规定的单词量为基准的,超出大纲的单词大都给以适当的汉语词义。 在答题形式上采取选择填空的形式。本书可供高中一、二、 三年级学生使用。书后附有参考答案,可供练习后对照。 由于水平有限,可能有不当之处,敬请使用本书者批评指正。
