

本書編彙之目的是爲一般準備赴美留學的青年在出國前對於 欲申請之美國各大學及獨立之學院,及各該校特點有明確的認識 及瞭解,同時亦能使讀者,估計本身之經濟能力,是否能負擔你 欲進入之學校所需要之費用,同時亦可使你瞭解各校可獲得獎學 金之情况,這樣才不致因隨便申請而誤進了一個學校。到達美國 後,因學校不適合自己志趣。甚至因不能負擔學校之昻貴學費, 又用盡了所帶去的錢,而流落海外,則更爲可惜了。 爲了節省讀者之費用,編者特在各校注明入學所須之考試: 例如 TOEFL (外國學生之英文能力考試)及 G. R. E (Graduate Record Examination 研究生入學資格考試)作爲 讀者欲申請學校時之參考,而且編者又將本書使用之中英文系別 列對照表,作爲讀者選擇科系時之參考。

本書在編輯期間,聘請了多位留美學者協助編輯及翻譯,全部耗費已超過新臺幣二十餘萬元,足見本書所具之價值及編者對本書編輯期間之嚴謹態度。若仍有謬誤疏漏之處,尚祈先進明達及讀者們不吝賜教匡正,則幸甚矣!
