前 言

为了适应我国高等教育发展的新形势,深化教学改革,提高教学质量,满足新时期国家和社会对人才培养的需要,教育部 2007 年 7 月教高厅[2007] 3 号文件颁布了《大学英语课程教学要求》(简称《课程要求》),作为高等学校组织非英语专业本科生英语教学的主要依据。

《课程要求》进一步界定了大学英语的教学性质:"大学英语是以外语教学理论为指导,以英语语言知识与应用技能、跨文化交际和学习策略为主要内容,集多种教学模式和教学手段为一体的教学体系;大学英语的教学目标是培养学生的综合应用能力,特别是听说能力,同时增强其自主学习能力,以适应我国社会发展和国际交流的需要。"听、说能力的培养是一个潜移默化的过程,从"读"入手,从"听"开始,以"说"为途径驾驭运用英语的能力。然而,随着各级大学学生的扩招,大班授课,影响了学生听说能力的培养。"读"、"听"做不好,何以谈"说"得好。部分学生感到很困惑,因为很难找到与他们水平接近的集读、听于一体,由浅入深的适合学生学习提高的教材。

为了使学生"听"的能力有一个循序渐进的提高,并适应即将实行的大学英语四、六级考试的机考新形式、新内容(新形式的考试中有对读、听的考核),我们组织编写了这本《大学英语听写朗读教程》。

本书编写具有以下特色。

- 1. 知识性。本书的素材含有丰富的知识,且内容、形式新颖,由浅入深。本书包括 日常口语、名人演讲、电影经典对白,以及教育、科技、健康、农业等方面的综合知识 和歌曲欣赏等内容。
- 2. 实用性。本书从日常生活中的常用口语短句开始,随后有四、六级考试中常出现的题型: 短文填空、短文理解。还有四、六级机考中即将出现的题型——时事新闻、电影对白以及英文歌曲填空,内容由浅入深,对学生听力理解、朗读能力的提高有很大帮助,而且适合各级英语水平的学生,可作为听力及朗读材料。
- 3. 前瞻性。本书配有外国专家录音的 MP3 音频,读音纯正,有助于矫正学生的英语发音;将提高朗读水平、侧重语言测试训练与能力培养、提高个人文化修养相结合;与大学英语四、六级考试改革的新题型相吻合。

《大学英语听写朗读教程》适合各级专业或非英语专业大学生及英语爱好者进行学习。本书对参加四、六级考试的非英语专业的学生极具实用价值,对想提高英语自学水平的专业学生或英语爱好者来说,也是一本难得的、使用价值很高的教材。

本书在编写中,参考了国内外出版的杂志、报纸及互联网上的资料,从中汲取了一些有用的材料,在此特向这些文献的作者和出版者表示感谢。本书中,李楠负责第一、七部

分的编写,姜海燕负责第二(部分)、三、四、六部分的编写,陈玉红老师负责第二(部分)、 五部分的编写以及校对、整理工作,刘丽、刘波老师负责其他部分资料收集、整理和校对 工作。

由于时间仓促,水平有限,书中难免有疏漏和不足之处,恳请广大读者提出宝贵意见,以便日后做出修订,使之更加完善。
