





前言 Preface

学习英语对于现在的人来说早已不是一件新鲜的事了。从刚刚上幼儿园的小朋友一直到社区退休的爷爷奶奶们,能说出一口地道的英语,能与老外聊天像和中国人一样溜是很多人这些年一直苦心追求的梦。在这样一个社交网络的发达的时代,越来越多的人想学好英语,更想说好英语,彻底告别中式英语,哑巴英语!能够随口说出一口流利地道的口语不仅可以为自己"镀金",提高自己的自信,同时也是对自己能力和修养的一个良好的提升。但是,我们学了这么多年英语,却发现自己的口语水平始终上不去,即便是会单词,知道什么意思,但真正的和老外聊天,或是看国外电影的时候依然不能理解他们在说什么。和老外"实战演习"时,总是感觉说不出口,有时甚至误解老外,最主要的原因就是我们对一些英语常用语的表达不熟悉,也就是我们经常说的只知道表面的意思,放在句子中就不知道如何理解了。要想解决这个问题,其实一点都不难。如果我们能够尽可能地融入真实的英语语境中,熟悉英语日常口语的各种表达方法,久而久之,就可以使自己的英语得心应手,运用自如。

为了能让这些英语学习爱好者们学到地道的美式口语,更好地理解美国俚语,我们精心编写了这本《这些英语常用语老外天天都在用》,通过各种情景对话来展现这些常用语的用法。本书主要以三个小动物和苏珊为中心人物,以他们在美国的所见所闻为线索来展开,内容生动有趣,对话通俗易懂,贴近生活,为读者展现出了原汁原味的表达。每个对话前面都配有情景介绍,以便读者更能地理解其中的语境。并且每一节的对话都有与之对应的译文,使读者能更准确地把握对话表达的意思。"生活常用语"板块引申出了更多的相似句型,在学习中可以起到举一反三的效果。词汇量的积累是表达丰富多彩语言的基础,单词短语吧可以让读者在学习俚语的同时增加自己的词汇量,避免语言单调。此外,我们还特意编写了"美国通"这个板块,把美国的生活习惯和娱乐休闲等各方面也生动地呈现给读者,以便让读者更好地了解美国的生活和文化,从而拓展了关于美国的知识面。




7. 场景真实, 生动贴切




4. 列举常用语,活学多用


