

序言

本册书是《中学生英语天天练》丛书高中一年级分册。

《中学生英语天天练》是中学生课外同步练习与自测的良 师益友,是为中学生毕业会考及升学考试而精心编写的一套 从书。本套从书分初中一年级、初中二年级、初中三年级及中 考综合练习四个分册和高中一年级、高中二年级、高中三年级 三个分册。各个分册密切配合现行教材,资料翔实,信息容量 大,可读性、实用性强。每个分册的内容包括单项填空、完形填 空、阅读理解、短文改错等内容。单项填空中的词汇练习,主要 是测试学生词特别是形容词和动词的搭配关系和用法,编写 中力求概括现行教材中的全部或绝大部分词语。对于一些基 础知识,进行了反复的训练。语法练习则以各册教材中出现的 语法现象,在单词和习语的应用实践中,测试学生所学的语法 知识和能力。完形填空、阅读理解、短文改错则测试学生的阅 读能力。其测试的目的是培养学生做题的准确性和速度。作 者力图帮助学生为各种考试做好充分准备。本书所编排的几 种题型,既适合于学生参加校内考试,又适合于初、高中统考、 会考及升学考试,同时也适合于专业职称进级考试等各种水 平测试,熟悉各种题型的题型特点及解题方法,由浅入深,逐 次提高,在帮助学生提高阅读能力的同时,不断提高学生的应 试能力。

鉴于学生刚刚由初中升入高中,知识衔接方面欠缺,故加大了练习量,强化了学生的语言知识。对学生尽快适应高中的学习,有一定的帮助。

本套丛书适用于初、高中学生,大学低年级学生,以及英语业余爱好者。

由于作者水平有限,加之时间仓促,书中疏漏和错误之处 在所难免,恳请读者不吝批评指正。
