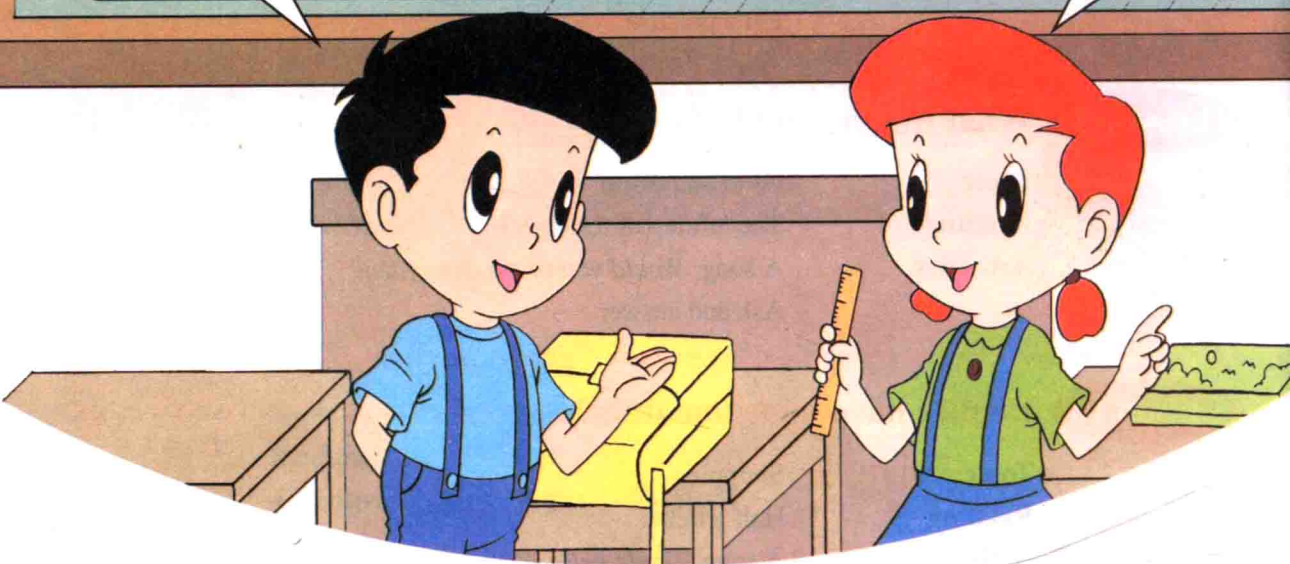

Do you have a long ruler?

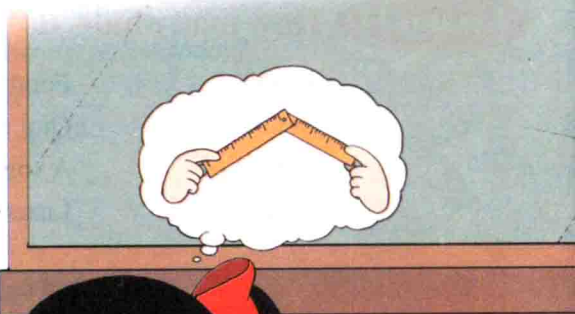
