



前言

《新活力英语口语》是依据教育部颁发的《高职高专教育英语课程基本要求》编写的英语口语教材。《高职高专教育英语课程基本要求》规定:高职高专教育英语课程教学目的是培养学生实际运用语言的能力,突出教学内容的实用性和针对性,具有用英语进行交流沟通的初步能力。《新活力英语口语》旨在帮助学习者学会用较为流利、地道的英语和得体的表达方式就校园日常话题以及职场话题进行口语交流。本教材可供高职高专院校非英语专业学生和英语专业低年级学生使用,也可供广大英语口语爱好者自学使用。

本教材共一册,分为上、下篇。上篇为校园日常口语,包括大学学习、友谊、校园生活、购物、文化、交通、观光、健康、饮食、关爱与安慰、社会实践、环境、婚姻、名人、时尚与娱乐15个话题。下篇为职场口语,包括面试、谈论工作、工作日程安排、商务约会、现代化办公、迎送客户、公司和产品介绍、市场调研、交易会、商务会议、商务旅行、洽谈与签约、辞职与解雇、投诉抱怨、紧急事件处理15个话题。

本教材每单元围绕一个话题展开,分为话题导入(Lead - in)、实用情景对话(Practical Dialogues)、学学做做(Learn and Say)、阅读与实操(Read and Act)、文化小贴士(Cultural Tips)和课后花絮(Tongue Twister, English Proverbs, etc.)。其中 Learn and Say 部分提供可供学生操练对话的相关句型,安排情景口语训练任务,帮助学生模仿和运用对话中的场景用语进行创造性的交际训练。Read and Act 部分选用与单元话题相关的短文和对话等,安排阅读与复述、阅读与角色扮演等口语训练任务,以增强学生的英文朗读能力、语言复述能力以及创造性使用语言的能力,达到巩固所学知识的目的。Cultural Tips 提供日常、职场和商务方面的综合常识,以拓宽学生的知识面。

Online Education

Before you download your application to a virtual university(网络虚拟大学), there are a couple of things you should know.

Unlike traditional campuses, online education programs rely on the Internet as the primary mode of communication. Lectures are taught through download materials, discussion forums and Web-based software that supplement print textbooks purchased for each class.

Online universities are built on the idea that people can get access to the Internet anywhere at any time. While most online schools are lawful institutions of higher learning, the Internet has made it easy for dishonest people to promote unreal schools. Therefore, you should do your research, check and double check if a school is right, and ask to speak with a few students and/or teachers before enrolling.

Features of the College Study

(大学学习的特点)

1. Studying at College(大学学习)

上大学是一个人一生中的重大转折点。大学学习要求高度自觉。与中学学习相比,大学学习在内容、方法和要求上都发生了很大的变化。要想真正学到知识和本领,必须适应大学的教学规律,掌握大学的学习特点,选择适合自己的学习方法。除了要掌握比较深厚的基础理论和专业知识外,还要重视培养研究和解决问题的能力。要特别注意自学能力的培养,学会独立地支配学习时间,自觉、主动、生动活泼地学习,同时还要注意锻炼思维能力、创造能力、组织管理能力和表达能力,为将来走上工作岗位打下良好的基础。

2. Initiatives of College Study(大学学习的主动性)

大学的课堂教学是提纲挈领式的。教师在课堂上只讲难点、疑点、重点或者是教师最有心得的一部分,其余部分一般由学生自己去攻读、理解、掌握。学生可根据自己的情况,选择适合自己的最有效的学习方法。因此,培养和提高自学能力,是大学生必须完成的一项重要任务。大学生不应死记硬背老师所讲的内容,而应按照自己的学习目标和专业要求,选择、吸收有用的知识,并努力去理解和消化。

3. Professional and Comprehensive Study(专业性与综合性相结合)

大学的学习实际上是一种高层次的专业学习。这种专业性,是随着社会对本专业要求的变化和发展而不断深入的,知识不断更新,知识面也越来越宽。为适应时代的发展,很多大学在进行专业教育的同时,还兼顾学生综合能力的提高。因此,大学生除了要学好专业知识外,还应根据自己的能力、兴趣和爱好,选修或自学其他课程,扩大自己的知识面,为毕业后更好地适应社会做好铺垫。
