序

要学习一种新语言，词汇自然是一个不容忽视的重要部分，它就好比一座大厦中的砖石，是奠基的材料。因此无论怎样强调学习词汇的重要作用，也不为过。但是我们往往发现人们在强调它的作用时，却又走入了一个误区：例如宣传死背单词的好处，甚至“发明”了各种各样的单词记忆法，好象只要把一个单词的对应汉语意义记下来，就万事大吉了。其实学习词汇，除了要掌握其意义外，更重要的是了解其用法。

刘思同志是有心人，教学之余还根据其经验编写了这一本专供英语学习者使用的《英语词汇用法正误对照》，这件事情本身就值得鼓励。我希望英语学习者不但在这本书里找到他们在学习英语中碰到疑难问题的答案，而且还能从中领悟出学习词汇的正确途径。

坊间关于英语用法的辞书也不少，但这本书有其特点：一是在选词上下了功夫，编者从她自身的教学经验出发，选的词都是常用而又容易搞错的；二是不但告诉学习者正确的用法，而且把容易犯错误的地方也点出来，并加以说明和辨析。当然也应该指出，任何一种语言的用法都是灵活多变的，没有什么用法是绝对正确，因此还要注意其实际使用，学习活的语言。

前　　言

通过较长时期的英语教学实践，亲身了解到学生在使用英语时的错误是屡见不鲜的，其中很多还是不可忽视的，有的还只因一字之差造成了交际问题。然而，这些错误不可能让老师在课内外一一纠正，更不可能得到说英语外国人的指正。于是，编著者收集整理了我国英语学生在使用英语时常犯的错误，加以纠正，辨析，编成这本书。目的是帮助大、中学生，包括自学的英语爱好者能正确使用英语，在参加各种考试，（尤其在改错，语法填空，写作等项目）时，从本书中得到裨益。

编写本书的具体指导思想和作法有：

1. 区别于语法书。没有罗列那些既累赘又千遍一律的规则；力求正误对照直观，让学生一目了然。同时，克服了有的同类书的弱点——即只有正误句，没有辨析，让人看了只知其然，不知其所以然——加入了辨析；既把为什么讲清楚了又简明扼要，让学生花的时候少，达到事半功倍的效果。

2. 选入的词是实用的；错误是常见的，尤其在口头交际和试题中常见。词条不求多，但求精；既侧重选入实词，即动词，名词，形容词，副词，也不忽视虚词，如介词，冠词的重要性。本书较系统地选编了介词类；还把冠词按四个部分分类说明：1) a(n) (该用与不该用 a(n))；2)

the (该用 the 与不该用 the); 3) the 和 a(n) (该用 the 还是 a(n)); 4) a 和 an (该用 a 还是 an)。这样条理清楚, 系统性强, 学生容易掌握。

3. 既有语法方面的正误, 也有语义方面的正误。比如有: probably, possibly 与 perhaps 的意义区别, disappointed at / about, disappointed in/ with 与 disappointed of 的语义差别; 也有 to demand 与 to request 不同的句法特点, 以及 until 在否定, 倒装, 强调各种句型中的不同用法。对于较难查到的, 如: alive, living 与 live; anxious, upset 与 nervous; ability 与 capacity; whether 与 if; that 与 which, 等等, 间的语义或结构区别, 都提供了答案。

4. 本书按词性分类, 各类按字母顺序排列, 便于查找。在辨析中另有例句, 进一步说明该词的用法, 有些还进行了类比, 扩展, 让读者能“举一反三”。这些例句针对性强, 不仅实用, 而且生动活泼。除了少数最简单的外, 大部分都译成了中文, 以便帮助基础较差的同学理解。本书把各条的辨析放在后面, 把表示错对的(×)和(√)放在词条正误句的后边, 目的都是让学生多动脑筋, 提倡先独立思考, 再看答案的良好学习习惯。

5. 为了保证准确性, 编著者在编写过程中参考了各家意见。有少数词的用法, 各种词典的解释和例证都是不同的, 甚至相互抵触。在这种情况下, 编者以 *Longman Dictionary of Contemporary English* (《朗曼当代英语词典》) 和 *The Advanced Learner's Dictionary of Current English* (《牛津现代高级英语词典》) 为主要依据。但是,

语言是千变万化的，正确与错误有时不能一刀切，因为在错对之间存在诸多因素的制约，如词汇使用的文体，背景，国家及地区习惯用法的差别。因而本书中的(×)，除了表示“错误”而外，在少数句后还表示“避免”或“不宜”使用。

本书在编写过程中，查阅了各类词典（如上面提到的两种和《新英汉词典》等）及有关书籍，有的例句直接引自这些词典，恕不一一加以注明，谨在此一并致谢。

本书的编写得到了全国著名教授，语言学专家桂诗春先生的热情支持和关心。他在百忙中抽时间审阅了本书的部分内容，并写了序。在此对老师表示衷心的感谢。还要感谢海南出版社，尤其是万胜编辑，没有他们的支持和配合，此书是不可能面世的。

欢迎各位英语专家和同行及广大读者提出宝贵意见。
