前 言

近年来,随着《大学英语教学大纲》的深入贯彻和执行,大学生的英语语言能力和交际能力都有了显著的提高。然而,在教学中我们发现,学生在中学阶段虽已学过了基础英语语法,但是在大学英语学习阶段仍不能较好地掌握系统的语法知识。结果出现了这样的情况,学生的交际能力上去了,但英语语言能力却没有相应地跟上去。究其原因,我们认为是学生手中缺少一本适合他们水平的实用的英语语法书。为了使广大的学生能随时查阅各语法项目,为不断巩固和加深语法知识,我们依照《大学英语教学大纲》的要求,从学生的实际水平出发,根据我们的英语教学经验,参照以往同类的书籍并吸取了各种英语刊物的精华,编写了这本《当代大学英语实用语法》。

《当代大学英语实用语法》具有系统性的特点。该书以《大学英语教学大纲》中的语法结构为框架,兼顾了中学英语语法知识体系,突出了大学英语学习中的语法重点和难点,基本上保持了传统语法的系统。这样,学生学起来不感到陌生,使用起来也较方便。

《当代大学英语实用语法》具有实用性的特点。该书在讲解时语言简明扼要,例句集中典型,译文删减得当。书中英语惯用法知识丰富,书后附录项目多样。该书既可作工具书使用,也可当教材学习。

《当代大学英语实用语法》具有知识性的特点。该书收编的例句详实新颖,难度适中,内容丰富,既有文学方面的,也有文化方面的,还有科技方面的,学生从众多的例句中不仅可以学到语法知识,而且可扩大词汇量,提高阅读理解的能力。

《当代大学英语实用语法》还配有一本语法练习册。除了个别章节外,练习与语法紧密配合。学生可边学边练,可先学后练,也可先练后学。学生可通过多项选择、找错改错和汉译英等练习形式来学习和巩固语法知识。
