编者说明

一、英国剑桥大学出版社出版的《历史杂志》(Historical Journal) 创刊于1958年。本索引收集该刊物自创刊至1982年的全部论文、评论文章和通讯的题录, 约800多条, 供世界历史工作者从事科研和教学工作时参考。

二、索引分为综述和地区国别两大类; 并以地区国别为主。凡涉及某一地区而不限于单一国家的史学文章, 它们的题录均归入各洲的综述或特定的地区一栏。某些国家因史学文章较少, 不宜单独列出, 统归各洲的“其他国家一栏”。

三、考虑到本杂志的特点, 国别顺序依题录内容的多少排列, 人物部分按姓氏的英语字母顺序排列。

四、索引收集的文章题录都标明年代、卷数和期号。例如: 1981, 24-3, 即指1981年第24卷第3期。

五、本索引由王丽芝同志负责收集和编排。如有遗漏和错误, 恳请指教。
